The political atmosphere in Europe does not look quite so lurid as it did a few weeks ago—Bismark has not taken a drink of brandy lately.

Hon. W. O. Hamilton, of Comanche, is a candidate for State Senator, subject to the action of the Democratic Senatorial Convention.

If a man cannot find a political party to suit his views this year, he is certainly hard to please. Democratic, Republican, Prohibition, Union Labor and People's party.

Attorney General Hogg is making it hot for the railroads. If he can make them keep their tracks and road beds in better repair, he will deserve the thanks of the entire public.

Well, yes, politics do seem a little mixed this year. The politician who breathes the storms which seem to be brewing in different quarters and not get shipwrecked, may count himself lucky.

The man with the hoe seems determined to enter the political arena this year, in the full panoply of glorious war. Should he do so in dead earnest, many old time politicians will bite the dust.

This very opposition is not being worked up with a hurra, but in the most quiet and effective way, therefore the more necessary to be met. In all this quiet agitation that is so formidable, the Chronicle if it is not mistaken, recognizes the cunning hand of the Republican leaders. If it is profitable to them to sow seeds of dissension will they not do so? They are wise shrewd men, and know how to use any and all elements of dissension to the best advantage and the history of that party is too well known to think they will hesitate to reap any rewards that may be in sight. We need a railroad over the "cattle trail route" and if the people of the town and county will all work together in conjunction with the citizens of Coleman county the road will be built from Coleman to this place in less than twelve months. This road, besides adding immensely to the taxable values of the county, would furnish employment for every man in the county that might need it. Let us not lose sight of things that will be worth something to us and turn our attention to politics entirely. Keep a weather eye on the politicians, but let us devote most of our time in trying to build up the county, and drive hard-times from our midst.

The Cottonwood Prodigal makes us blush, but we will "try" to deserve the compliments paid us by the Prodigal in last issue as follows: As we were going to press with our last issue THE BAIRD STAR rose upon our vexed vision. THE ROCK ISLAND. The engineer corps making the survey between Baird and Coleman, completed their work, tying on to the Santa Fe depot in Coleman, last Tuesday forenoon.

Chief Stanley M. Jones, the engineer in charge, informs us that there is little or no difference in the grade between these two points and Baird and Albany. He has not yet completed his estimates but likes this end of the route even better than the other and says that the whole length, from Albany is the best sixty five miles he ever surveyed for a railroad in Texas. The grade on the whole route will not quite reach 5500 yards to the mile—all dirt.

Estimating the grading at 13 cents per yard the grading will be less than \$715. (The cost as far as the estimate is made up, is but \$705.) or \$46,000 in round numbers.

Mr. Jones estimates that \$85,000 will grade, bridge and tie the road from Albany to Coleman. Now these towns are offering the Rock Island a bonus of \$75,000 right of way, depot grounds etc. This is worth of way, depot grounds, etc. this right at least \$40,000 more, or an aggregate of \$115,000. Why not save this extra \$90,000 by building the road ourselves? For \$60,000 we can have it prepared ready for the iron from Coleman to Baird. Parties have already offered to bond it at \$15,000 per mile, as soon as it is ready for the iron and contractors propose to do the grading and not ask a dollar until their work is completed.

This is the best opportunity we will ever have to secure a north and south road across the state. The offers are generous, the territory is now open and no rivals are in the field.

We should not delay a day in occupying the territory and proceeding to build the road, as other companies in Texas have done. Idle capital is inviting us to begin the work, our own interests are urging us to it and nothing but timidity on our part can prevent success.—Coleman Voice.

Demagogues and the People.

The man who appeals to the prejudices and passions of the people and teaches them to distrust and hate their government, for the sake of office, is a monster that no words are vile enough to describe. But the country is swarming with such men. They create strife and bitterness, and often cause good people to fear that our land is going headlong to ruin. But the Banner has no such fear, because it has an abiding faith in the saving sense and integrity of the people. The expert demagogue can deceive all of the people some time and some of the people all of the time, but he cannot deceive all of the people all of the time.

Our government has its faults. There are evils to be corrected. There are policies only half way carried out. There are difficulties to overcome. Ignatius Donnelly's book on the Bacon cipher is outdone and anticipated by a still more startling revelation that appears in the May Cosmopolitan. The writer, Edward Gordon Clark, claims that by applying Bacon's cipher to the original Shakespeare epitaph the apparent grotesque varieties of lettering are resolved into most surprising confessions concerning the life of Bacon and Shakespeare. The traveler, Wolf Von Schierbrand, furnishes a pleasing sketch about "Children in Persia" and Joel Benton gives many amusing specimens of "What our Grandfathers Laughed at Two Hundred Years Ago." Besides E. P. Roe's popular serial story of southern life at the end of the war "Miss Lou," there is a notable short story of the Stevenson type, entitled "Dr. Brendt's Wife," which is a strong piece of work. Mathew Arnold's memory is enshrouded in a sonnet by his friend Joel Benton. Other poetic gems in the same number are by Danske Dandridge, Anna Vernon Dorsey and Edith Sessions Tupper.

THE NEW YORK DELEGATION. It is now stated that the delegates at large from New York to the national Republican convention will be ex-Senator Platt, Senator Hiscock, Chauncey M. Depew and Whitelaw Reid. The first three names were decided upon several weeks ago, but there was quite a contest for the fourth place, between Senator Evarts and ex-Governor Cornell. It has finally been decided, however, that both of these leaders shall look to their districts for places on the delegation and that Whitelaw Reid shall be made the fourth delegate at large.

Of course, there is no question in regard to the presidential preferences of these delegates. They are the leaders of the popular movement to nominate Blaine in spite of his refusal to become a candidate. It is said that the New York delegation will go into the convention solid for the Maine statesman and that his name will be presented by the brilliant Depew. The popular feeling in favor of Blaine's nomination is so strong in the empire state that the party leaders cannot ignore it. They are compelled to fall in with it and to be led by those who are usually their followers.

It is conceded on all sides that great deference should be paid to the wishes of New York in the selection of a candidate. And when New York declares by the unanimous voice of her delegation that her choice is James G. Blaine, his nomination will follow as surely as the rising of the sun.

BAIRD, TEXAS, May 8, 1888. You are requested to assemble at this place on May 25, 1888, to be present at a mass meeting of the citizens of this county, to take steps to secure the immediate construction of the above line. This proposed line, the most desirable, direct and inexpensive line from the Eastern centres to West Texas, will when completed, control all the traffic from our section of the state and will be one of the great trunk lines of the West.

Already sixty miles of this line from Albany to Coleman, via Baird, has been subjected to a careful instrumental survey by one of the most experienced locating engineers in Texas, Maj. S. M. Jones, and there are now on file with the undersigned, complete topographical maps and accurate profiles of the six miles and the estimates thereon are extremely moderate for a first-class railway, which this must be. It is desirable to extend the surveys south to Kerville and to Vernon on the north—at once. Also to take immediate steps to place under construction the sixty miles already located.

Your attendance is desired to inspect the maps and profiles and work already done. It is confidently believed, from assurance already received, that if each county will do its part of certain requirements, that the actual construction of this road may commence in the next ninety days. The members of the committee's above, are requested to invite to come with them, any citizens of their counties who may be interested in the work. With a united effort along the "cattle trail," the new trunk line can be secured; but action must be taken at once.

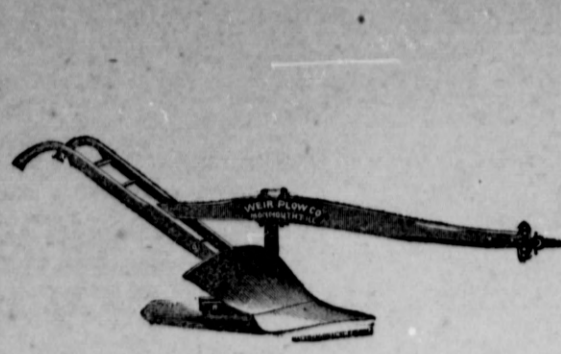
