But what does interest me is: What is being done to help our boys grow to manhood without having the idea that birds are here only to be shot by them. Say, boys, let us leave the birds alone! It's bad enough to have "pussy" get away with harmless song birds, but that is cat-nature; boy nature is for something nobler than bird-killing, or any wanton killing for that matter.
