When they wrote their Gospels, Mark and Luke say that it was to anoint Jesus's
body for final burial according to John, Jesus's "wrapped with the spices in linen cloths, following the

immediately after crucifixion. (John 19:40). It must be accepted that there are several minor details of what happened after the

In short, our Christian
faith is founded on one fact: faith is founded on one fact:
that Jesus rose from the
dead dead. Today we are not able
to witness those surrounding the discovery o
the empty tomb in the same
way as the apostles did. We way as the apostles did. We
must rely on someone

testimony. We rely on Pe

(ibid) "Now I,

mine can winss to every-
