## Vote For The Bonds In the Election Sat., Dec. 28

This election calls for the voting of $\$ 360,000000$ in bonds, maturing over a period of 20 years, with interest not exceeding 4 per cent.

It is further provided that their issuance will be upon the condition of their assumption, in both principal and interest, by the State Board of County and District Road Indebtedness. The election order contains the following clause:
> "The bonds will be issued and sold and the tax levied in payment thereof, when the County receives from the State Highway Commission and the Board of County and District Road Indebtedness, definite assurance that the road hereinabove described will be taken over, acquired or purchased by the State of Texas, and that the principal and interest on said bonds will be paid out of funds lawfully appropriated or set aside for that purpose by the proper State Agency."

Voters may rest definitely assured that the bonds will not and cannot be issued or sold, by the present or any future Commissioners' Court, unless the provisions of the above clause are carried out; in which case the bonds will be paid 100 per cent from the proceeds from Ic of the State Gasoline Tax, which is set aside to retire county road bonds.

In the construction of this important road, needed work will be provided for many of our citizens; and upon its completion, we will have a direct route to North Central and Central Texas, saving at least 25 miles over present routes.

All persons who are legally qualified voters of Foard County, who are resident taxpayers on either real or personal property, and who have duly rendered their property for taxation, are entitled to vote in this election.

We believe this is a genuine opportunity to extend our road system in co-operation with the State Highway Authorities, without cost to us; and for this reason are supporting, and urging the voters of Foard County to support this issue.
