the site could reveal valuable data about Post-Ar-
chaic and Paleo-Indian oc-
cupation and their cupation and their respec-
tive adaptataions to changing
environments, the Commis tive adaptations to changing

sion story said. The National Register is a
nationwide inventory of
nistoric historic properties consider-
ed to be worthy of preservation for their cult
ural and historical values. This designation does not
infringe upon the private infringe upon the private
property's rights of the site
owners. It does owners. It does offer a
measure of protection from
disturbance in any federaldisturbance in any federal
ly-funded or licensed project
such as highway such as highway or r
voir construction.
