
## Stampede Rodeo Parade Thursday

A dance at the rodeo ground slab near the arena Saturday night will feature Hoyle Nix and his band.

Sunday morning at 9:30 religious services will be held in the rodeo arena with Jim Fullingim conducting the services.

This group is well known to many people ers were Japan and and was featured in an article in the January 1970 issue of "The Western Horseman." They are remembered by those 120,900 who have been associated with Hardin-Simmons since the group's inception in the early 1930's. Members of the class of 1951 probably recall the horses' march down Michigan Avenue in Chicago.

Although the exact date of the group's first appearance is uncertain, it is known that the creation of the group was due primarily to two men. Gilbert "Gib" Sandefer, then manager of the Cowboy Band, and "Sheriff" Will Watson promoted the idea for the Six White Horses and soon had them marching in parades throughout the nation.

In the early days Watson rode one of the horses, carrying Old Glory and wearing a white western outfit. On the opposite side rode a co-ed carrying the Lone Star flag. Between were more co-eds, each carrying another of the six flags which have flown over Texas during the past 400 years. This flag motif, coupled with the western

flavor, make the horses a natural representative of Texas in out-of-state appearances. The group, along with the Cowboy Band, were picked to represent the state in the parade held as part of the Presidential inauguration of 1969. Texas rodeo fans have become accustomed

to the sight of the Six White Horses leading their grand entries and then taking up a position at the far end of the arena. There the six white quarterhorses, with riders and flags, make an impressive picture.

Even movie stars are acquainted with the unit. In 1967 John Wayne invited the Six White Horses and the Cowboy Band to put in an appearance in Dallas and Fort Worth to help publicize the world premiere of his new movie, "The War Wagon."

The group has not changed much since its early days. Watson, now dead, has been replaced by another co-ed, the group now consisting of six horses and six co-ed riders. Individual horses have been replaced due

to age and more colorful tack has been added, including leather and silver saddles donated by Acey Lockhart in 1975. The remuda now consists of eight quarterhorses. They are kept at the

University stables when not traveling. None are aristocrats of the horse world since color, size and disposition are far more important than bloodlines.




