Two of the best 3A football teams in the state of Texas battled to a near stand-off here Friday night as the number one ranked Littlefield Wildcats disrupted the Post Antelope homecoming in a 14-7 defensive

A jam-packed, fence-row standing-roomonly crowd witnessed two powerhouse offensive teams slam up against equally strong defenses.

In the end, Littlefield's experience and over-all team size made the difference, as the 'Lopes were unable to take advantage of crucial turnovers and third down situations. Littlefield's Steve Green displayed the

kind of power running fans expected to see, and the Wildcat offensive line consistently punctured the line of scrimmage.

Post's all-state running back Milton Williams got untracked late in the third quarter and put on the sort of running show Antelope fans went to see, but except for the lone touchdown drive, Williams was stymied by a hard-hitting Wildcat defense.

The first quarter ended in a 0-0 tie, and the Wildcats didn't get a score until late in the second quarter, following a 10 play drive that

The Antelopes opened the game, driving in nine plays to the Littlefield 37 before punting the ball, the first of two bad snaps that Curt Greer handled.


