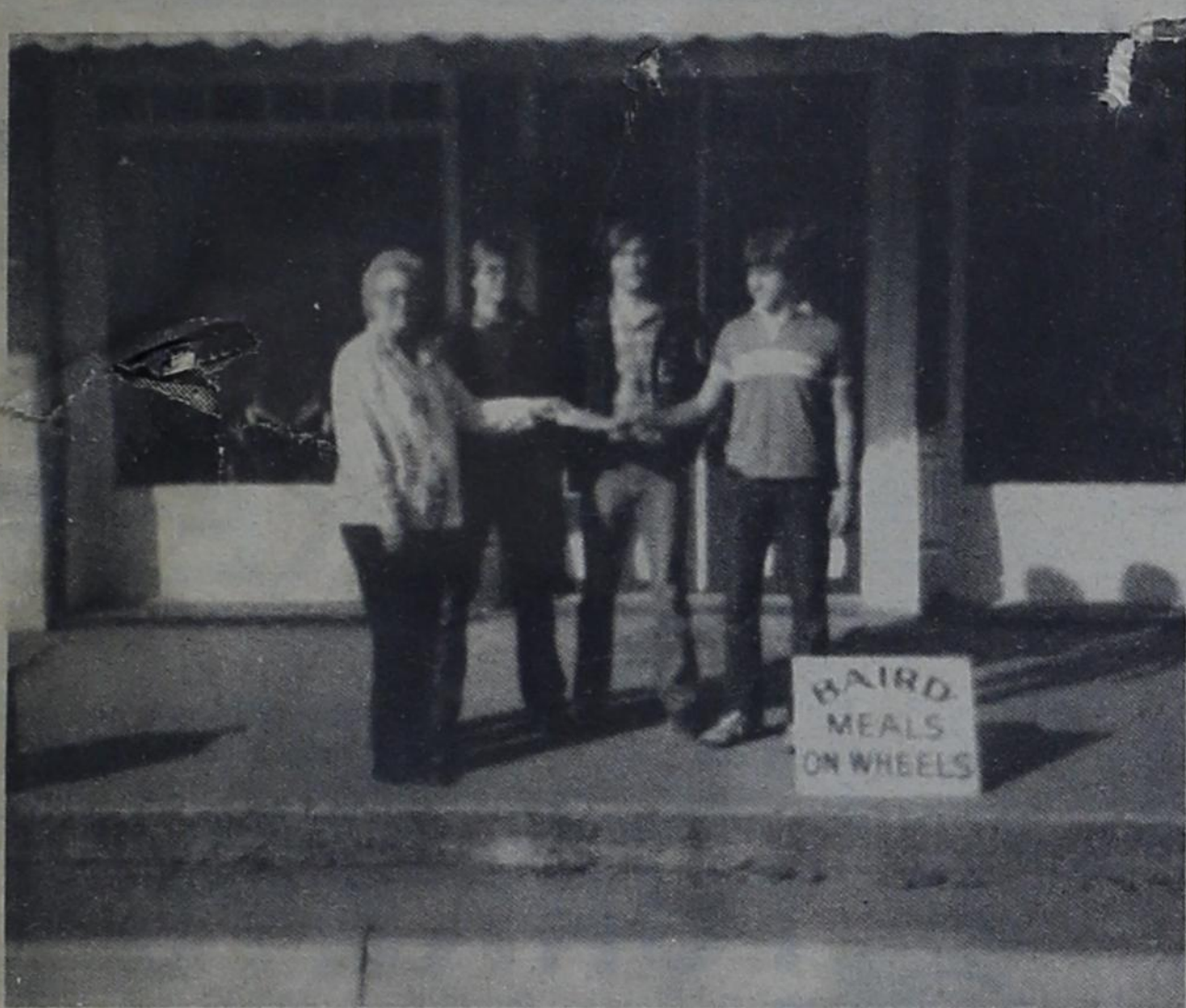

Sheriffs Dept. Identify's Victim, Investigates, Burglary

Callahan County Sheriff's have positively identified the victim of last Tuesday's accident, involving a Eula school bus, as Lonnie Joe Richardson of the Dallas area.

Richardson was accidentally struck and killed by the bus at approximately 10:45 p.m. last Tuesday night at the Eula exit on F.M. 603 and I-20.

The next-of-kin of the victim was contacted in Morningsport, La., and the body has been transported to Dallas. Funeral services are pending.

Identification was made with the help of the Abilene Police Departments Detective Lawrence in CID.

Investigation is in process of last Thursday burglary that occurred at the Bill Prock residence in Eula. The burglary occurred between the hours of 8 A.M. and 1:30 P.M. at which time numerous items were taken.

Sheriff Bill Skinner urges county residents to take precautions and keep a close watch on their homes during

this holiday season. Because it is the time of year that rural burglaries increase.

From County Attorney Robert McCools office it was reported that Bryant Smart received 6 years in the penitentiary on charges of auto theft, and Samuel Carington was sentenced to 5 years, deferred, on involuntary manslaughter charges.

Reagan Gamble and Lesley Pugh plead guilty to theft charges of rifles and scopes that were stolen back in August and September. Mr. McCool

said that Gamble is expected to receive 8 years probated and 5 years probated.

DeWayne Smith has been accused of the theft of some saddles and is awaiting trial. J. Paul Shanks was assigned as his attorney.

McCool said cases are pending investigation in several thefts and a medical fraud case involving prescriptions. He anticipates charges to be filed in the next 7 to 10 days. The next scheduled District Court will be January 6, 1983.

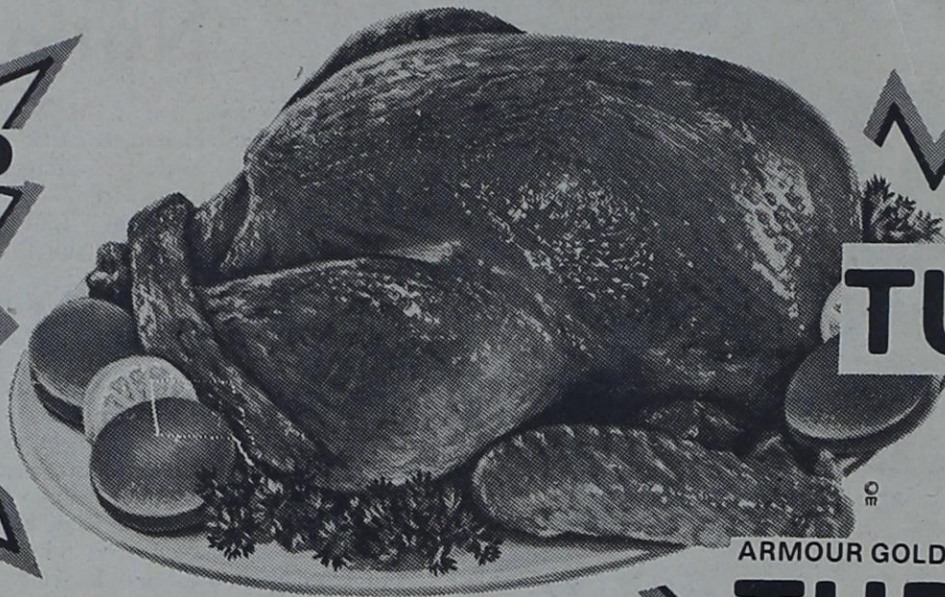

Tax Rate Discussed At Special Council Meeting

A special meeting was held Thursday by the Baird City Council where a new tax rate was discussed and council officially approved the hiring of B.H. Fillmon for night watchman.

Mayor Payne explained that the new tax rate will be .10 less than last year's, but will be approved in Monday night's meeting.

The budget has required an increase for next year of about \$10,000 in order to meet the high cost of maintaining existing facilities and making improvements.

The council agreed to meet Monday and set the new tax rate.

B.H. Fillmon was officially approved by the council as night watchman for Baird. He has agreed to work for the same pay and conditions as the previous watchman, except he will not be able to qualify for retirement until he has worked one year.

The council discussed the possibilities of purchasing a radio for the night watchman. They agreed to give it some thought and to discuss it at the next regular meeting to be held December 27.

Larry Cheshire, of WTU, appeared before the council to have them approve

the new rate 4.6% that was approved by the P.U.C. when WTU requested a 9.9% increase. The rate was approved by the council.

Also discussed at the meeting was commercial dumping at the landfill. They agreed to leave the fee of \$10.00 per load in effect for commercial use.

Mayor Payne said that he had contacted Gilbert Kanady, who lives out at the lake and had given him a 90 day notice to move his house and vacate the premises. The date given Mr. Kanady was March 15th.

A total of \$2,900 was also discovered by the Mayor to be owed to the City for Shady Oaks land lease. Shady Oaks offered to pay \$1,000 and call it even but the council did not agree. "The money is owed", the mayor said, "to the City of Baird, not the council." The council said they would discuss this issue more at the December 27th meeting.

Mayor Payne and City secretary Billy George Morgan said the city had a busy year filling streets, laying a new water line to a new addition, work out at the lake and a big clean-up at the City's warehouse.

Meals-On-Wheels Holds Luncheon At New Location

Approximately 34 guests enjoyed themselves at the luncheon that was served Thursday at the Meals-On-Wheels new location. Brisket, (prepared by Billy George Morgan), ham, and a variety of salads, vegetables and desserts brought the guest back for seconds.

The atmosphere at the new location, located next to R%R Manufacturing on Market Street, is warm and comfortable.

Frene Lee, director, said that approximately 60 meals were delivered from the

facility. The meals free to some, or only \$2.00 for those who can afford to pay. The government subsidizes a portion, but Meals-On-Wheels must match 30% of that.

The front curb outside the building has even painted yellow for a loading zone. Everyone is asked to observe this and not park there between the hours of 7 A.M. and 1 P.M.

This will be the last luncheon until after the first of the New Year.

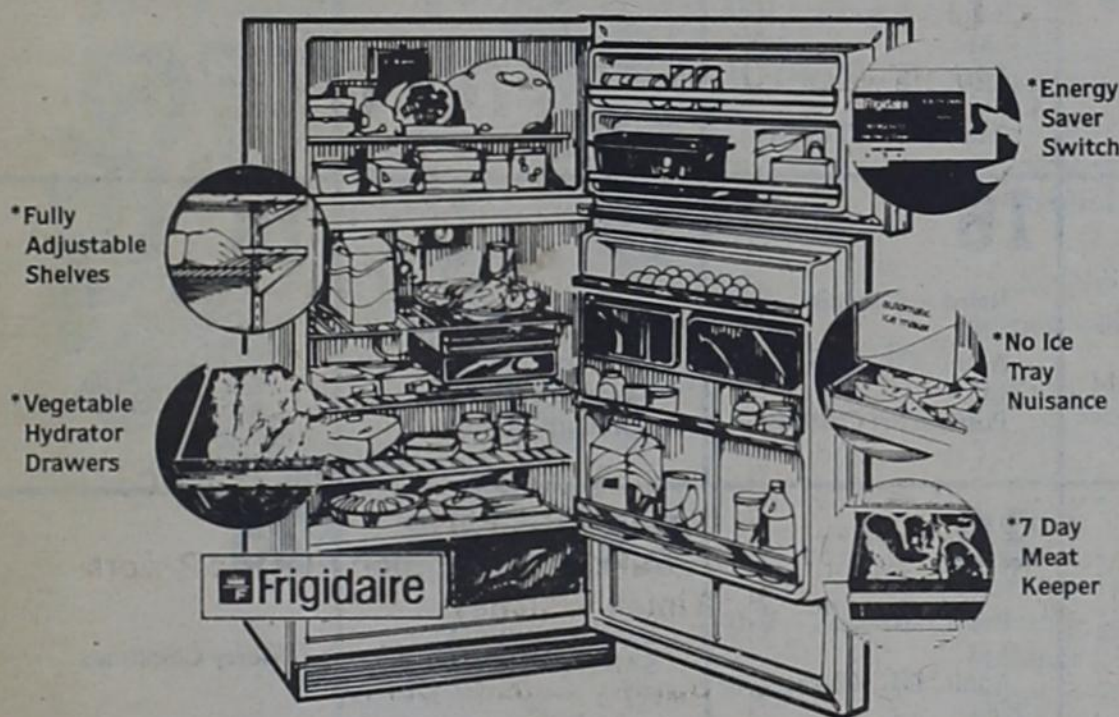

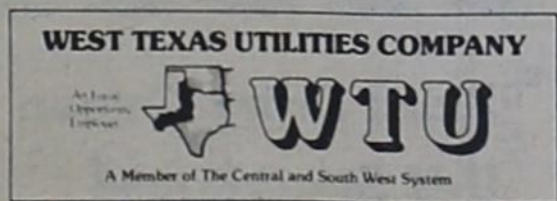

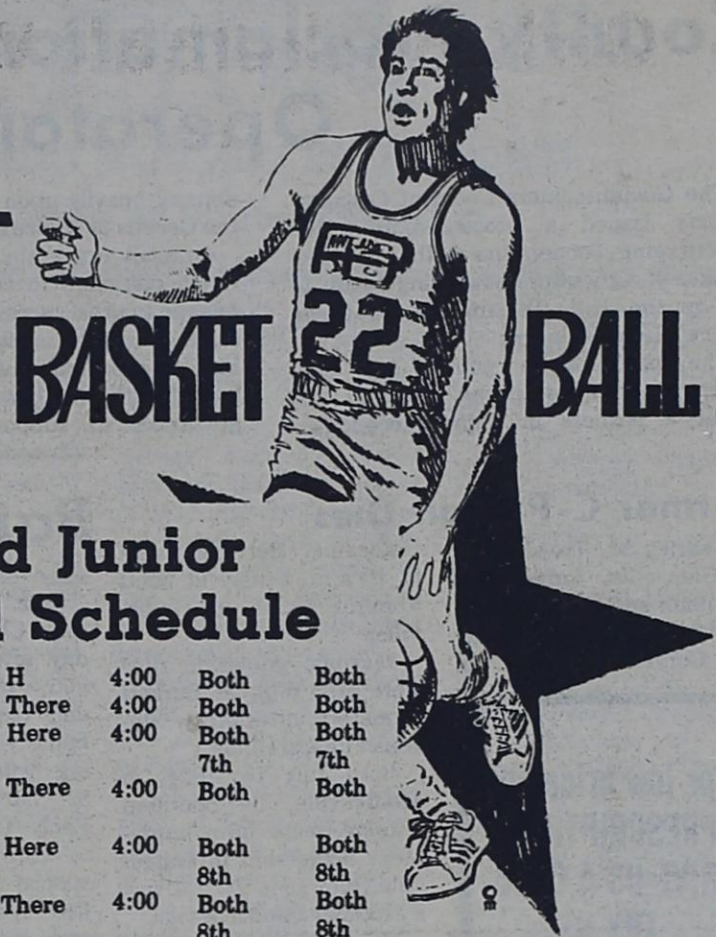

County Proclamation Encourages Farm And Ranch Operators To Complete Census

The Commissioners Court of Callahan County issued a proclamation today encouraging cooperation with the 1982 Census of Agriculture now being conducted by the U.S. Department of Commerce's Census Bureau.

The proclamation points out that "many business decisions affecting the county's farmers in today's economy,

depend heavily upon accurate data from the Census of Agriculture."

Officials urged the county's farm and ranch operators to complete the census questionnaires accurately and return them promptly to the Census Bureau. Similar proclamations are being issued by officials of other counties and state governors in support of the census,

the 22nd in a series that began in 1840.

The current census will update the findings of the most recent farm census conducted for 1978 operations. Census figures are used in many national and state programs affecting agriculture which are designed or allocated on the basis of this data. These include funds for extension work, soil conservation,

research, and other services. The more dependent a county is on agricultural income, the more vital census information becomes, local officials point out.

Because a successful farm census depends upon farmers and ranchers completing their report forms accurately and quickly, the Census Bureau is seeking the cooperation of each county's agriculture and business leaders.
