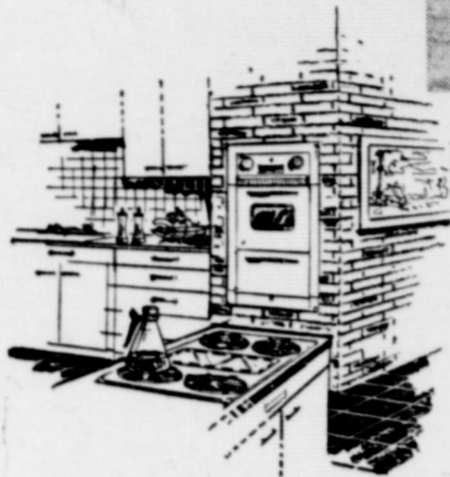

How to determine the number of income tax exemptions you get shouldn't be too much of a problem for most taxpayers. However, more people get tangled up with the Internal Revenue Service in an audit of their tax return over dependents than any other item. The law is liberal on allowing exemptions for children attending schools even though they may have earned enough income to file a return on their own. The taxpayer must make sure that each dependent meets the requirements spelled out in the tax instructions. It pays to carefully study your tax instructions on dependents. You may find you are entitled to some extra \$600 exemptions by reading these instructions. On the other hand you may find that you are not entitled to an exemption and save yourself an audit by Internal Revenue.

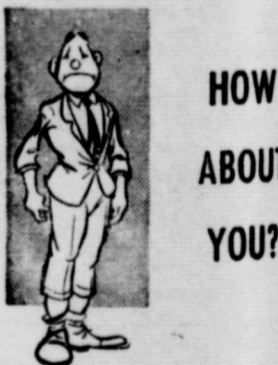

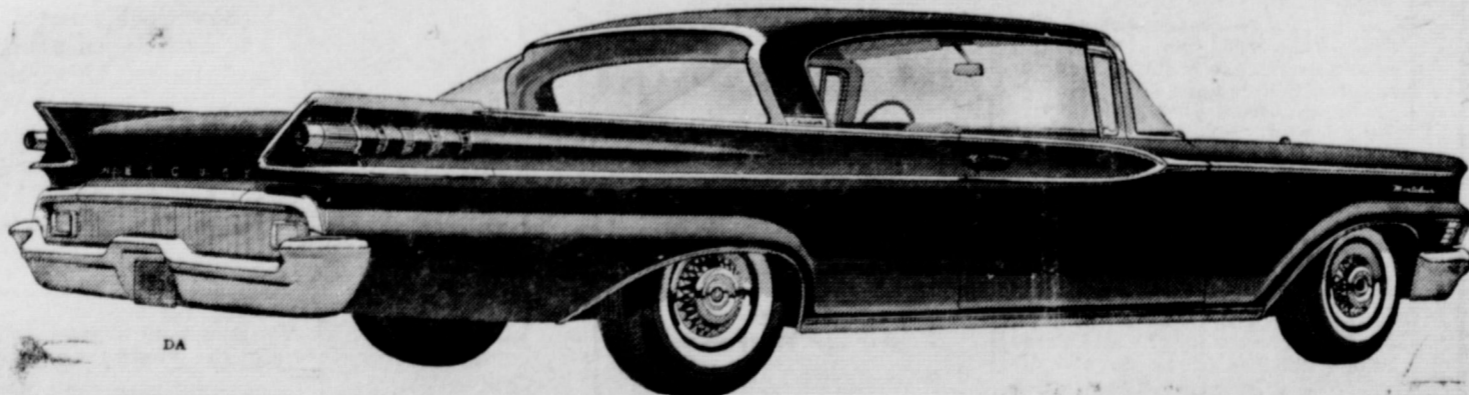

Brown patch, a rather common lawn disease, is especially active in the warmer sections of the State at the present time. Terraclor used at rate of one pound per 1,000 sq. ft. of lawn will give excellent control. The material should be watered down immediately after it is applied. This may prevent possible leaf burning and will get the material down into the turf where it is most effective.

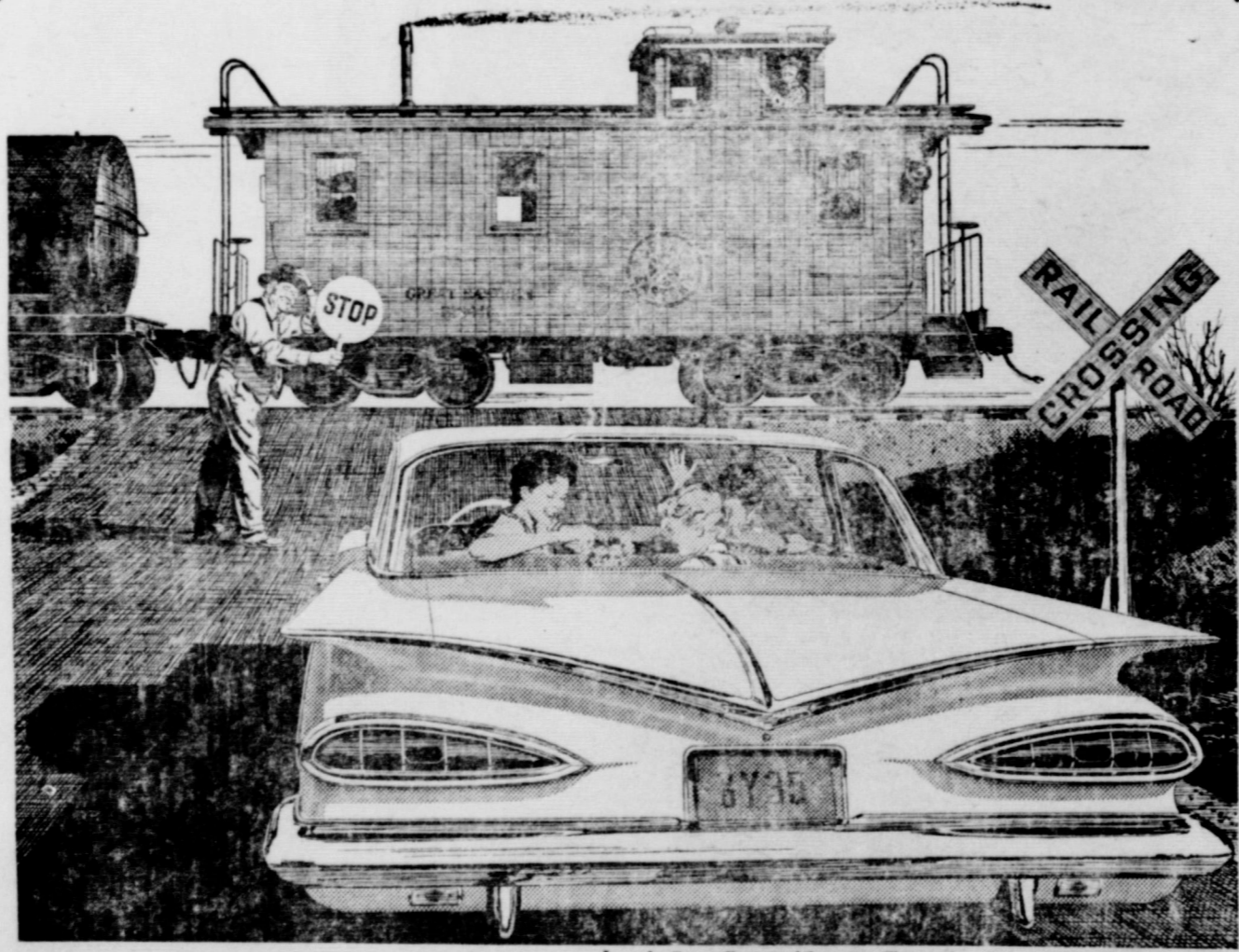

WHITE COFFIN NAILS

It all started with Sir Walter Raleigh and a Y-shaped pipe.

The pipe was a gift to Raleigh from Sir Francis Drake -- a souvenir from the West Indies where natives put the pipe prongs in their nostrils and inhaled the smoke of a smouldering substance they called "tabaco." Raleigh apparently set the style of his day for when he took up smoking the practice soon became fashionable. All this happened nearly 400 years ago. Since then smoking has become the most deeply ingrained habit of humanity.

In this nation 26 million men and 14 million women smoke.

The death rate for cigarette smokers is 58 percent greater than the rate for non smokers. Moreover heavy smokers die off quicker than light smokers. Brown patch, a rather common lawn disease, is especially active in the warmer sections of the State at the present time. Terraclor used at rate of one pound per 1,000 sq. ft. of lawn will give excellent control. The material should be watered down immediately after it is applied. 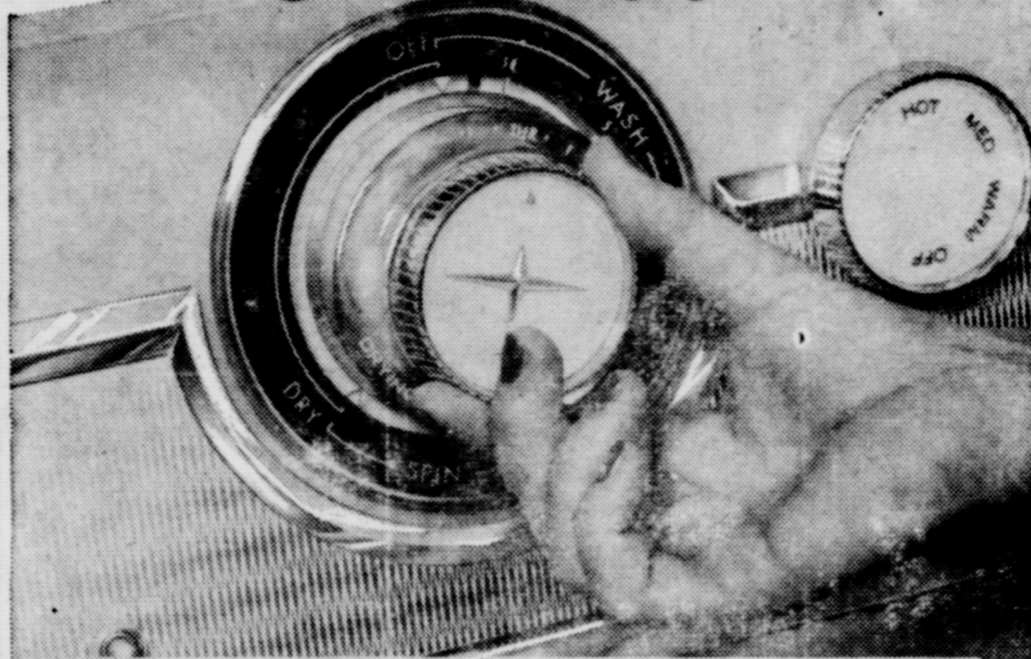
