Coffee 'Sneak' Becomes 'Break' in Los Angeles

LOS ANGELES—The first municipal recognition of man's inalienable right to drink a cup of coffee during working hours on the bosses' time is working out fine for both the City of Los Angeles and its 15,000 employees.

Los Angeles became the first U.S. city to legalize coffee breaks for municipal workers when it passed an ordinance authorizing employees to take 15 minutes each morning and afternoon at no loss of pay or time to themselves.

According to Leask, replacement of the coffee "sneak" with the regulated coffee break has been a decided "plus" operation for the city.

"The purpose of making the coffee breaks legal and regulated was to increase work output and thus promote efficiency and economy in the conduct of city business," he said.

"Just like the coffee break in offices and factories, our city rest periods have ended time-wasting 'sneak outs' and other abuses which were costly to taxpayers."

RIPLEY, Miss.—The new mayor of this small town, Mrs. Ruth Street, 54, was elected without asking for a single vote.

She had been appointed to the post to fill out the unexpired term of her husband, Mayor John B. Street, who died in office.

After she attended a few aldermen's meetings, she said that the board of aldermen in session is just like a missionary society—they just talk and do little.

Mrs. Street is Mississippi's only woman mayor.

Lady Pitcher Saves Man's Life

LANCASTER, Wis.—A farm woman's throwing arm got the credit for saving a farmer's life.

Ray Slater, 60, Ellenboro Township, nearly suffocated when his wrecked car was almost submerged in a cold creek.

Mrs. Helen Beyer, called by the farmer's children, began throwing rocks at the rear window. The first rock hit but bounced off. The next two missed.

Slater held his nose to the broken window for more than an hour until a wrecker pulled the car from the water.

He was able to keep his face above water in the back seat.

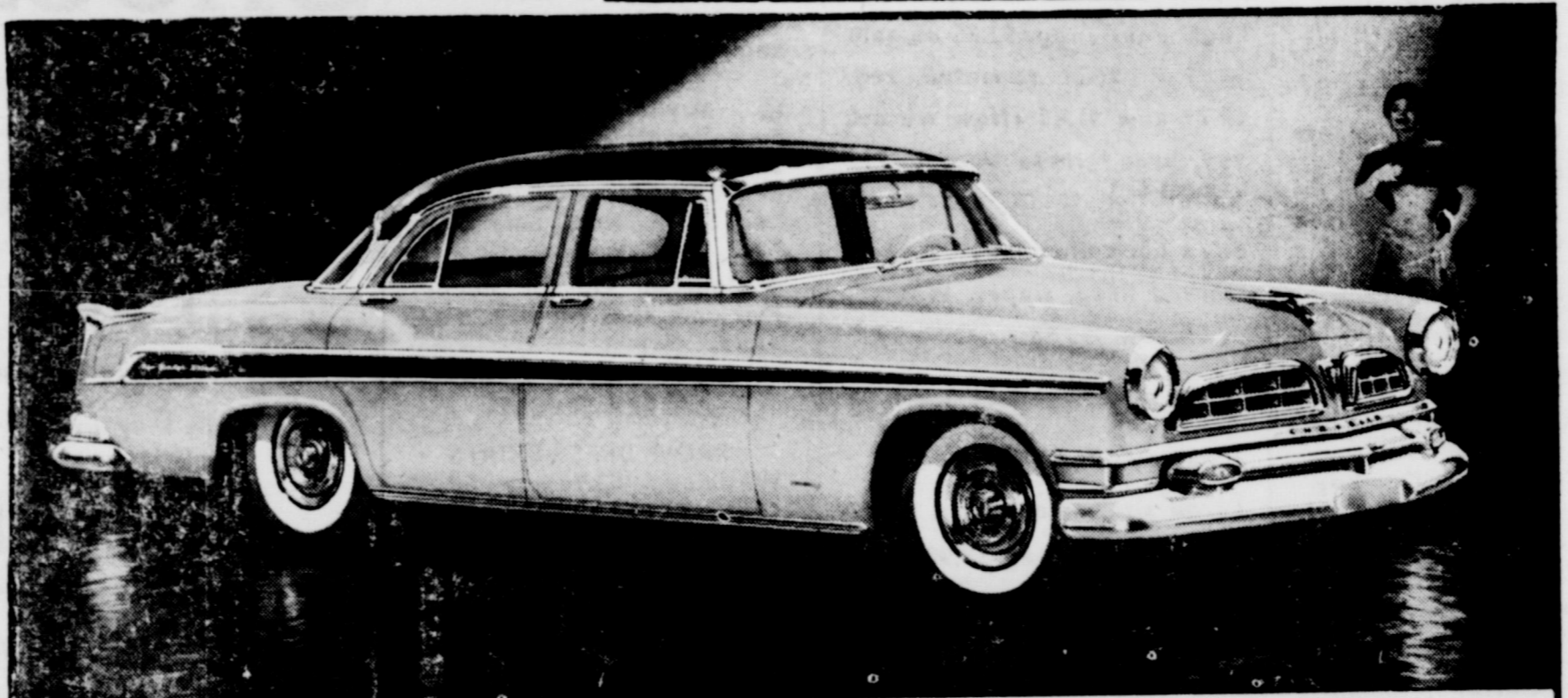

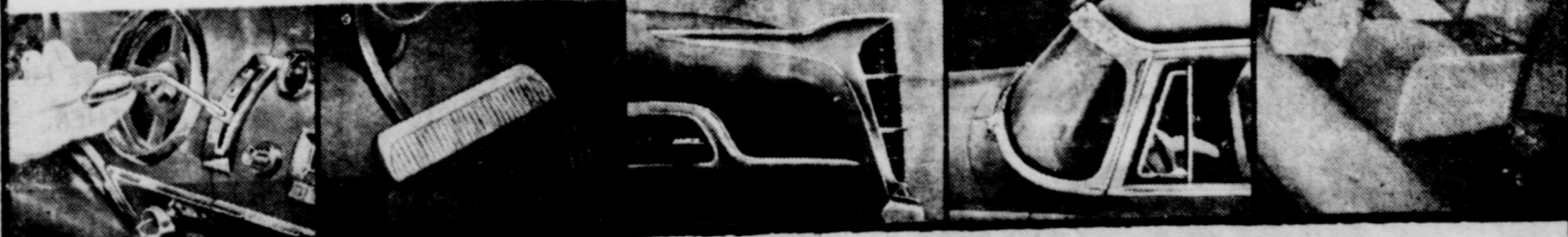

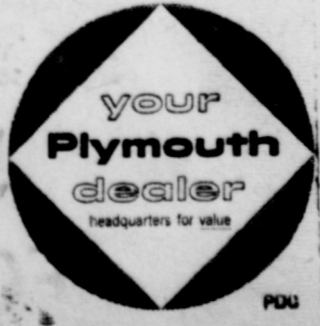

Know Your Law

Most criminals have a good idea of their rights in court, but the average citizen, confronted with a arrest ticket or court summons, has little knowledge of the protection provided for him. Having had some experience with the courts, he is apt to view with a sinking feeling any document requiring his presence in court. However if he is innocent of the charge and knows his rights as a citizen in court, he need have no fear of appearing before judge and jury.

Probably the most fundamental and important right is summarized in the well known until proved guilty man is innocent until proved guilty. It is up to the prosecuting authority to prove that the person on trial is guilty -- and not the obligation of the person accused to prove that he is innocent. The prosecution must prove your guilt beyond a reasonable doubt or you will be acquitted. The mere fact that you have been given a ticket or accused of a crime is not even evidence of guilt. Another important protection is the right to have a witness whose testimony you may need subpoenaed to appear in court and testify. Many

people are reluctant to go to court when their own rights are involved, and unless you had a means for compelling their attendance and testimony, you often would be unable to prove the facts necessary for success in your case.

VA Quiz

Q -- I am an ex-WAC, planning to attend school under the Korean GI Bill. My husband is working. Will VA pay me the added GI allowance for a veteran with dependents, even though he is working?

A -- No. You could claim the added allowance for your husband only if he were in fact dependent upon you.

Q -- As a member of the reserves, I receive pay for attending weekly meetings and going on active duty two weeks each year. Will this pay be deducted from the monthly al-

lowance I receive as a student in college under the Korean GI Bill?

A -- No. Reserve pay will not be deducted from your GI allowance. Neither will any other outside earnings you will receive. Under the law the monthly allowance for school-going veterans remains the same, regardless of outside income of any kind.

Q -- I have a permanent GI insurance policy which lapsed several months ago. To reinstate, I understand I will have to pay all back premiums. Will I also be required to pay interest on the premiums?

A -- Yes. You will be required to pay interest at the stipulated rate for your type of policy.

Q -- I am thinking about paying the additional premium on my GI insurance policy, so that if I become totally disabled for six months or more I will receive a monthly payment from VA. If I should become disabled, would these payments I receive be deducted from the face amount of the policy?

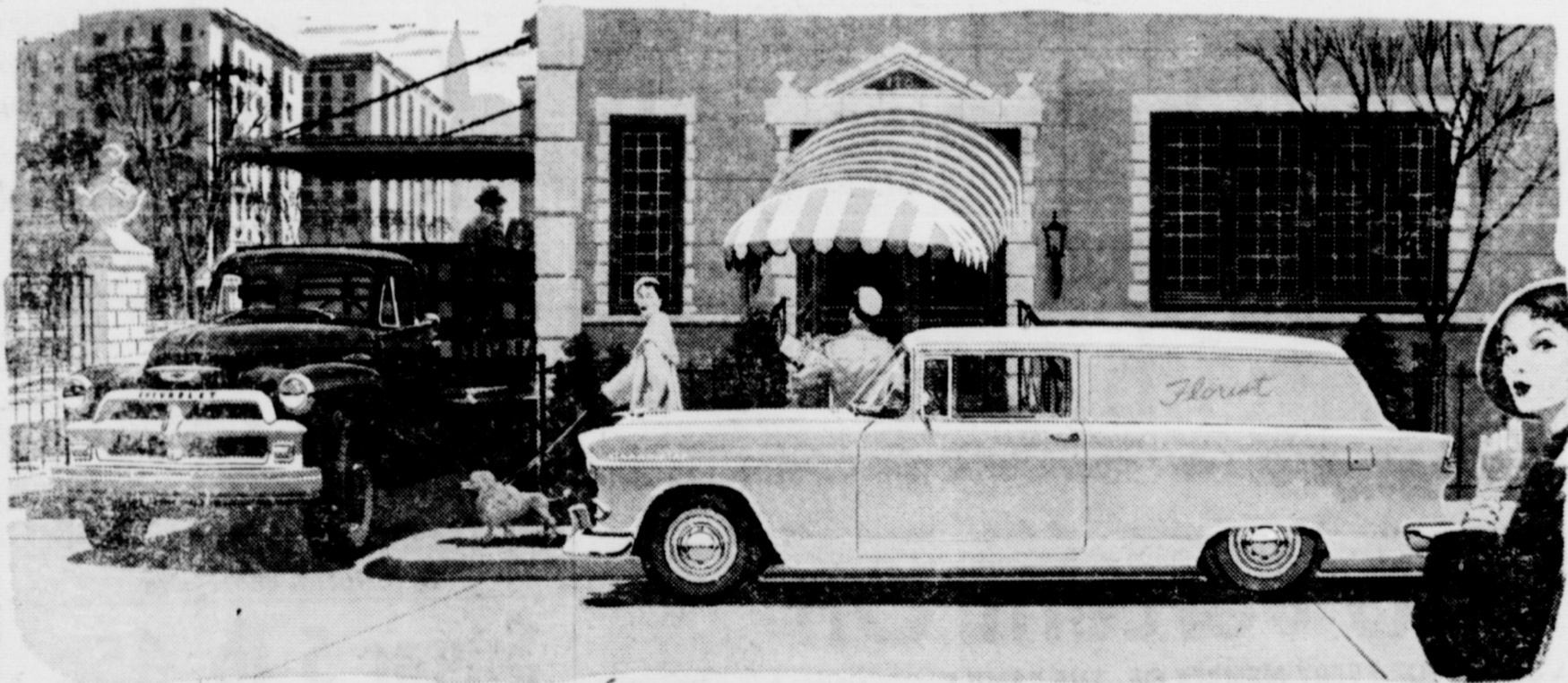

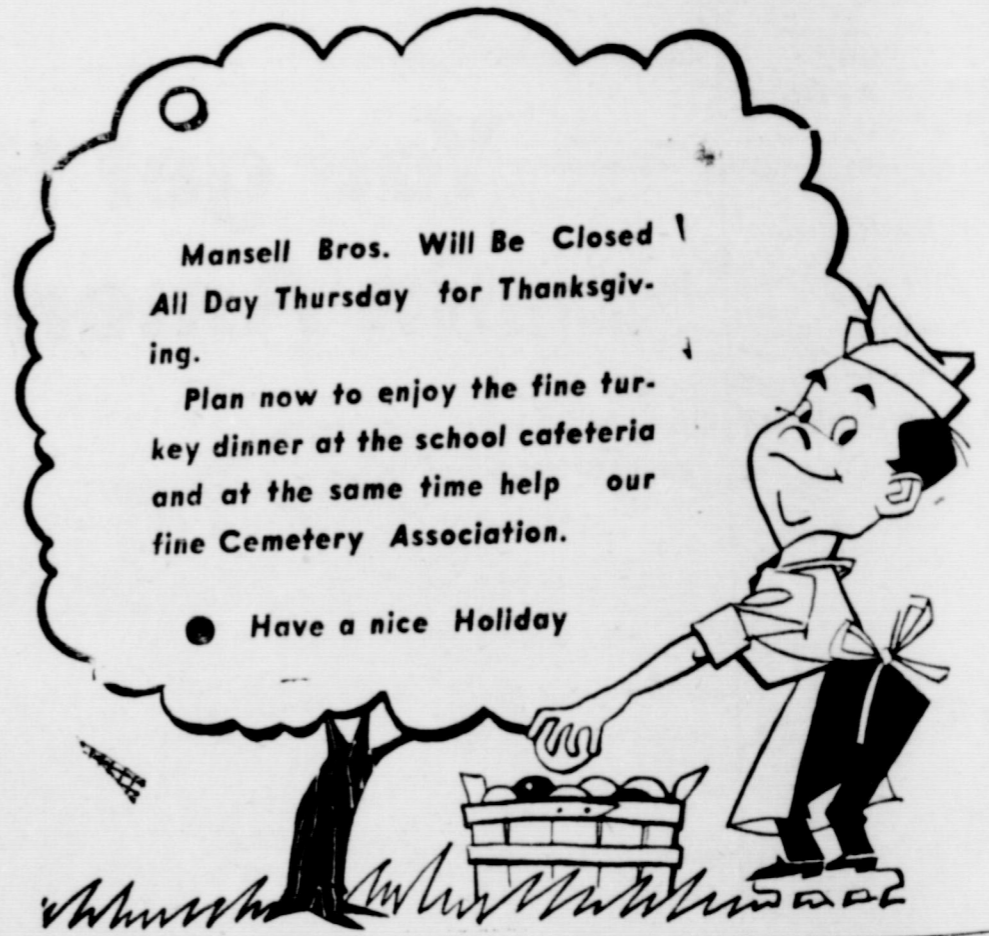
