

### AAA COMMITTEE COMMENDS JUDGE P. W. GOAD

We denounce the rumors and false reports that have gone out over Lynn County that P. W. Goad has failed to cooperate with the Farm Program, when in truth and fact, he has cooperated in every possible way and we, his friends, refer you to your own County Committee and urge you to consult them and get first hand information. We also quote herein in full a letter from the Agricultural Adjustment Administration:

committee. We have observed the fine way in which
the county agent, home demonstration agent, and
the A. A. A. have cooperated and wish to express
our appreciation. our appreciation.

We feel that this should and will right a great injustice that has been done Judge Goad.

We most heartily indorse him for re-election to the office of County Judge for the following reasons:

First, he is a man of strong convictions and absolutely free from all outside influences and special interests. Second, he has given a fair and square deal to everyone without fear or favor. Third, he has given an undivided service, having no other occupation or business to absorb his time while holding this office. Fourth, he has positively refused to neglect his duties as a puble official to promote his own personal interest and political ambitions.

Fifth, he has given to the people of Lynn County a progressive and conservative program. Under his leadership, the expenses of the county have been reduced approximately \$3,000 per year. Seventh, he is recognized by state and federal authorities as being one of the outstanding County Judges in Texas. He is well and favorably known by both State and Federal officials which makes it much easier for the county to secure State and Federal aid, for highway construction and various relief projects.

Therefore, we feel that with the record he has made and the knowledge he has of the needs of Lynn County and the experience he has had in handling the affairs of the County, it would be a tragedy should we fail to re-elect him to this most responsible office at this most crucial hour.
