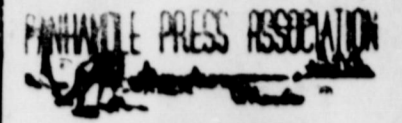

New Holy Bible

Revised Version Available

SEVILLE, Ohio—This town joined with 3,000 hometown communities throughout the nation recently in celebrating the new Revised Version of the Holy Bible, latest version of the Bible to be published.

The local observance, sponsored by the Seville Ministers Association, was held in the Presbyterian church.

A presentation of the need for a new translation of the Bible, along with the values to be obtained was given. Several local persons who were chosen by the ministers' association received one of the new Bibles.

No Skeeters Pester Ormond Beach, Fla., After Experiments

ORMOND BEACH, Fla.—There are no mosquitos left in this small village, reports Dr. Morton C. Kahn, Cornell university medical college professor.

Last spring, the insects were so thick in town that the residents dared venture outside only when it was necessary. Mayor Leo Foley heard of Dr. Kahn's experiments and invited the professor to help Ormond Beach rid itself of mosquitos. Dr. Kahn promised to experiment.

Dr. Kahn took his assistants, Dr. William Offenhausser Jr., Dr. Daniel Alvarez and Edward Berg, all of the department of public health of the medical college, and his equipment. The equipment, on which Dr. Kahn has been working for 14 years, consists of a recording device, a phonograph and loudspeaker, and an electrically charged grill.

In Ormond Beach the scientists captured specimens of aedes taeniorhynchus, bothering Ormond Beach by day, and aedes sollicitans, bothering the village by night. They recorded the low-pitched love cry of a female of each insect. Then they set up the grill in front of the loudspeaker and turned the electricity on. Mosquitos were lured from miles around, and they perished on the grill as they plunged headlong into the loudspeaker.

Earlier tests indicated that the siren voice of the female mosquito lured only males to their deaths, Dr. Kahn said. The new tests indicated that females also were lured by female mosquito voice recordings.

Community's Video Antenna Helps Areas in 'Fringe'

LACONIA, N.H.—Towns and villages in television "fringe areas" throughout the country can learn a lesson from this resort community.

Video fans all over this mountainous area had been harassed by unclear and unsteady TV pictures, and sometimes no picture at all, largely because the signal from a television broadcasting antenna does not "bend" like radio beams, and, therefore, it won't go around or through a mountain. Many towns which are "around the corner of the earth" from the nearest broadcasting station—or which, like Laconia, are snuggled behind a mountain—receive little in the way of good television.

Citizens here got together and formed a company which has succeeded in building the first antenaplex community television antenna in New England. At recent opening ceremonies for the new system, Governor Sherman Adams of New Hampshire said it resulted in "the finest television picture I've ever seen."

The antenaplex system consists of a 40-foot antenna atop 2,400-foot Mount Belknap with amplifiers and a cable strung on poles 6,000 feet down the side of the mountain into Laconia. It took engineers of the RCA service company and a special construction crew nearly a year to complete the project, but residents agree it was worth waiting for.

HURST GREEN, Eng.—"Little girls can't become angels." The Rev. Charles Godfrey Bell said so in a sermon recently. He began a debate which has stirred this village of 700.

The trouble began when the vicar objected to the erection of a marble angel over the grave of Kathleen Reese, 9. A Church of England official refused to permit the memorial, but citizens petitioned the Archbishop of Canterbury to sustain the faith of little children that they can become angels.

The vicar maintains that angels are a separate order of creation, and that man when he dies does not become an angel, but one of the family of God.

Angels and men worship together, and often, particularly at Christmas time, they sing together. The Rev. Mr. Bell preached. Often, when a person is in difficulty, a guardian angel comes to his side, and may call to his assistance the archangels Gabriel, Michael and the rest, he said.

Mr. and Mrs. Ernest Reese, the parents of little Kathleen who may have no angel over her grave unless the archbishop overrules the vicar, were not satisfied with the clergyman's explanation.

"It is not a question of whether there are angels," said Reese. "The point is that a little girl had been taught to believe in them, and did believe in them."

The parents said they had letters from sympathizers all over the country who believe that Kathleen should have an angel over her grave.

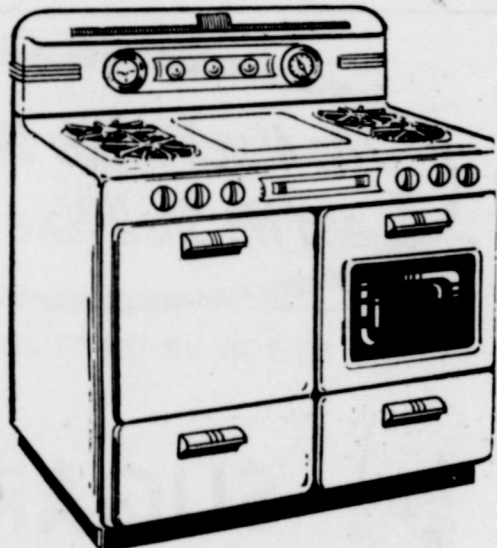
