INTERNATIONALLY KNOWN TEAM OF EVANGELISTS TO SPEAK IN SAN ANGELO

The Fogarty Brothers, well known evangelists of the Churches of Christ, will be the featured speakers at a 22-day "Big Tent Revival" meeting to be held in San Angelo starting Saturday, June 7. 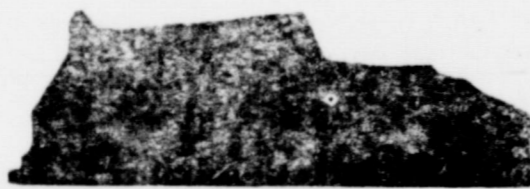

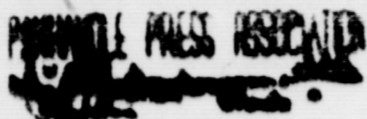

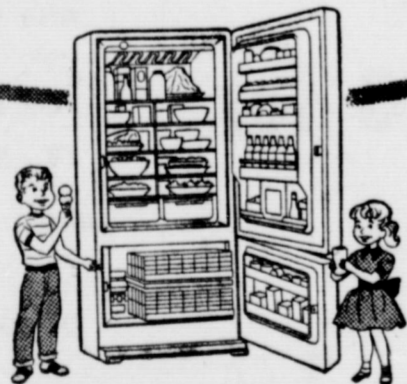
