WHO MUST FILE A FEDERAL INCOME TAX RETURN

All citizens or residents of the United States, including minor children, who had gross incomes of \$600 or more in 1961 must file a federal income tax return. John J. Sloan, of the Lubbock Internal Revenue Service said today.

If the taxpayer is 65 or over as of December 31, 1961 he or she is not required to file unless his or her gross income for 1961 was at least \$1,200. The IRS representative added that even though a taxpayer is not required to file under these rules, he or she must file to obtain a refund, if any income tax was withheld from his or her pay.

He said there is one exception to the general rule. Self employed persons such as sole proprietors, partners and independent contractors, must file an income tax return and pay a self employment tax if net earnings from self employment were \$400 or more.

Filing deadline this year is Monday, April 16th.

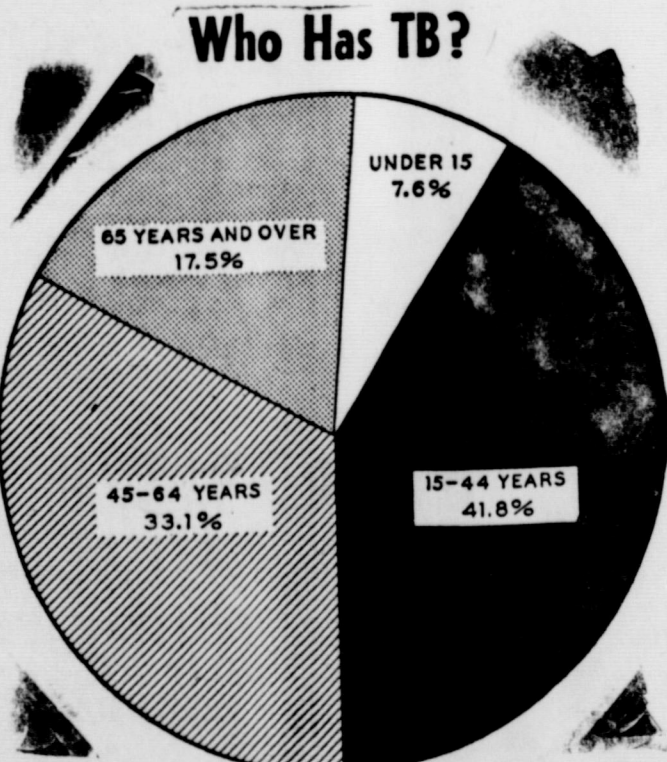
