CENTERVILLE, Ala. — Every body in this town is mighty friendly. James Allen Brewster, 5, thinks His neighbors have lavished many gifts and toys upon him, things he often has wished for but which now he can't hold or fondle. He has lost both his hands.

His hands were caught in a saw-mill slab chain. He was treated in a hospital. When he returned home he gazed ruefully at the bandages where his arms ended and said, "Now I won't be able to play anymore."

Centerville folks had been too busy helping the boy's dad, S. A. Brewster, pay the hospital and title doctors to think about toys for the small lad. They had already raised about \$300 for medical expenses and \$40 to buy James some clothes.

After his sighing remark about not playing again, James went uptown with his sister, Mary Dean, 12. He wore a neat sports shirt, blue jeans and new shoes. His sister bought him a soft drink and held the bottle while he sipped. Then they went home.

Upon arrival, they found the toys that the people of Centerville had been too busy to buy before. James was so happy that he declared he would learn how to play all over again.

The larva of the heel fly, the cattle grub grub, is now appearing as a jump under the hide in the backs of dairy and beef cattle. Now is the time to control them. Local county agents can supply formulas for dipping, spraying and dusting, says C. F. Garner, assistant extension entomologist.

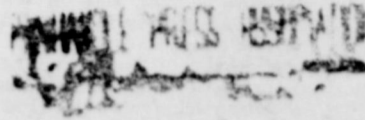

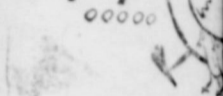

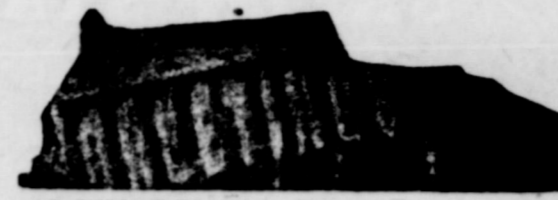

God's Cure For Sin

It has never been within man's ability to atone (make amends) for his own sin. We cannot by doing a multitude of good deeds make for our transgression of God's law. Since separation from God is the result of sin, this simply means that God won't listen to our pleas until atonement has been made for our sins. (cf Isaiah 59:2) That Christ died for us is taught in many places. (cf Romans 5:7-9; 1 John 1:7.) Now, since Jesus died to atone for our sins, does that mean that all men will be saved by his sacrifice? Indeed it does not. Christ died to make it "possible" for men to have their sins forgiven through him, but no one is "compelled" to come to him for salvation. This is expressed in the statement, "And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that OBEY him." (Hebrews 5:9.) To the man who does not obey Christ, he is not the author of salvation.

Since we must obey Jesus there is something "we" must "do" to accept him and having accepted him, we must continue to obey him. We read, "There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are "in" Christ Jesus." (Romans 8:1.) If we can learn how we get into Christ where there is no condemnation, we will also learn how we may accept the sacrifice Jesus offered on our behalf on the cross. Thus in Romans 6:3 we read, "Know ye not, that so many of us as were BAPTIZED INTO JESUS CHRIST were baptized into his death?" Baptism, therefore, is the means of our getting into Christ where there is no condemnation and where there is forgiveness of sin. We should note, however, that baptism is not acceptable in God's sight unless it is preceded and accompanied by belief (John 3:16) and repentance (Acts 2:38.) But baptism is the means of getting into Christ which is the only place where we may avail ourselves of his sacrifice for our sins.

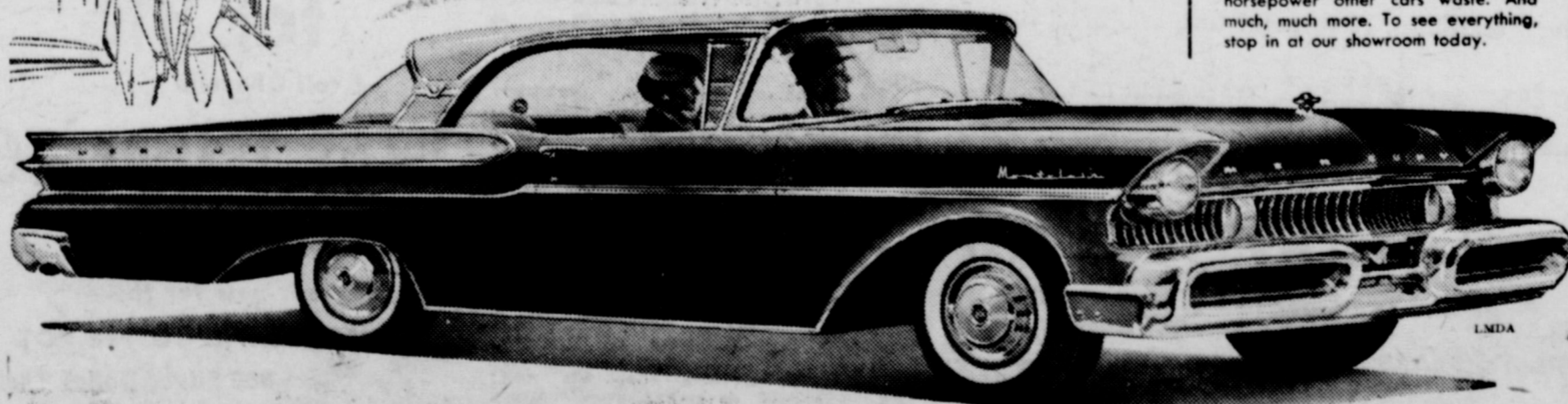
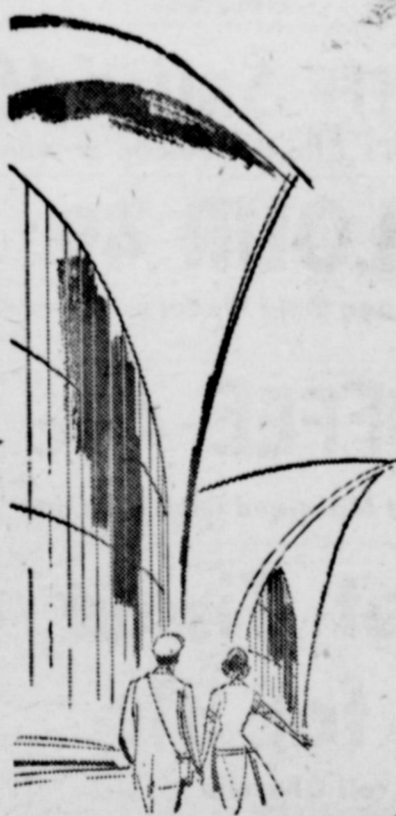
