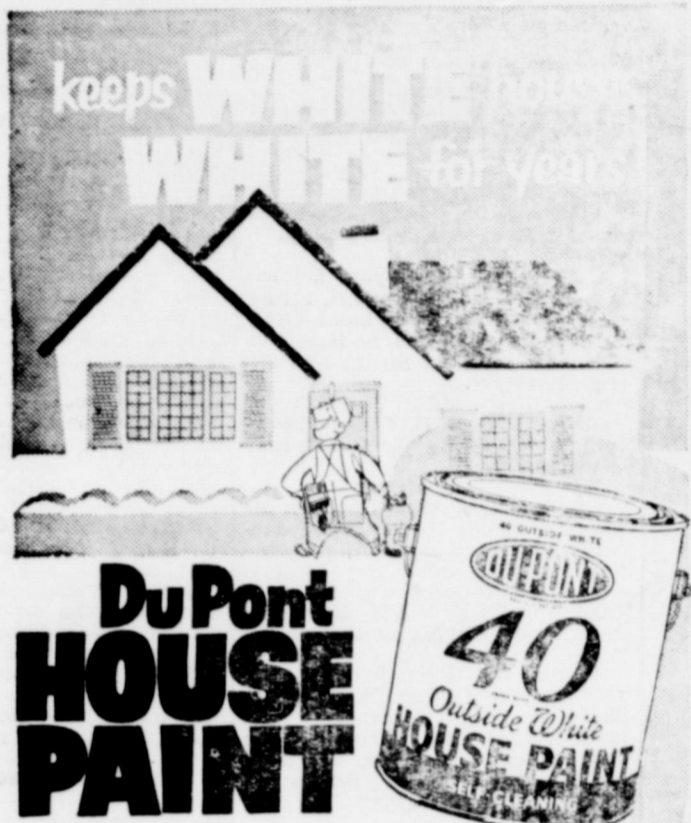

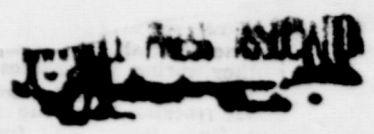

FANNON WAS TRACK STAR IN COLLEGE

Ranking among the nation's top hurdlers, Ken Fannon of O'Donnell dropped the curtain on his collegiate track career with Abilene Christian College last Saturday night in Houston.

Fannon served as captain of the 1957 ACC track and field team and is the holder of the all-time record by a Wildcat performer for the high hurdles of 14 seconds flat.

He turned in performances of 14.2 for the highs and 22.6 for the lows this spring. That clocking for the lows was his career best.

In high school he was a three-sport letterman and set state records of 14.7 and 19.4 his senior year in winning the state titles for both the high and low hurdles. Fannon ran a 14.3 and 23.1 for two third places in the Meet of Champions last Saturday night, the final races of his career.
