Farmers Are Warned About Use of Poisons Respirators Advised For Dusting Operations

This summer American farmers and gardeners will use about 1,000,000,000 pounds of bug-killing materials, much of it containing parathion, especially those highly effective on the destructive leaf aphid.

Insecticides containing parathion are used a great deal by commercial fruit producers.

Now produced by several chemical companies, parathion in its original state is a brownish liquid. But as a commercial insecticide it



Respirators should always be worn when handling parathion-base insecticides. Protective rubber gloves also should be used since the toxic chemical can be absorbed through the skin.

comes in powder form to be used for dusting or mixed with water for spraying.

While highly effective on insects, parathion also is extremely poisonous to humans. That is why some kind of respirator is recommended for farmers and growers spraying or dusting with insecticides containing the chemical.

A light weight and not uncomfortable respirator, with a molded rubber facepiece has been developed by the Mine Safety Appliance company of Pittsburgh which will fill the needs of most farmers.

Proper equipment on the modern farm is essential if the farmer is to protect himself, his employees, and gain top production.

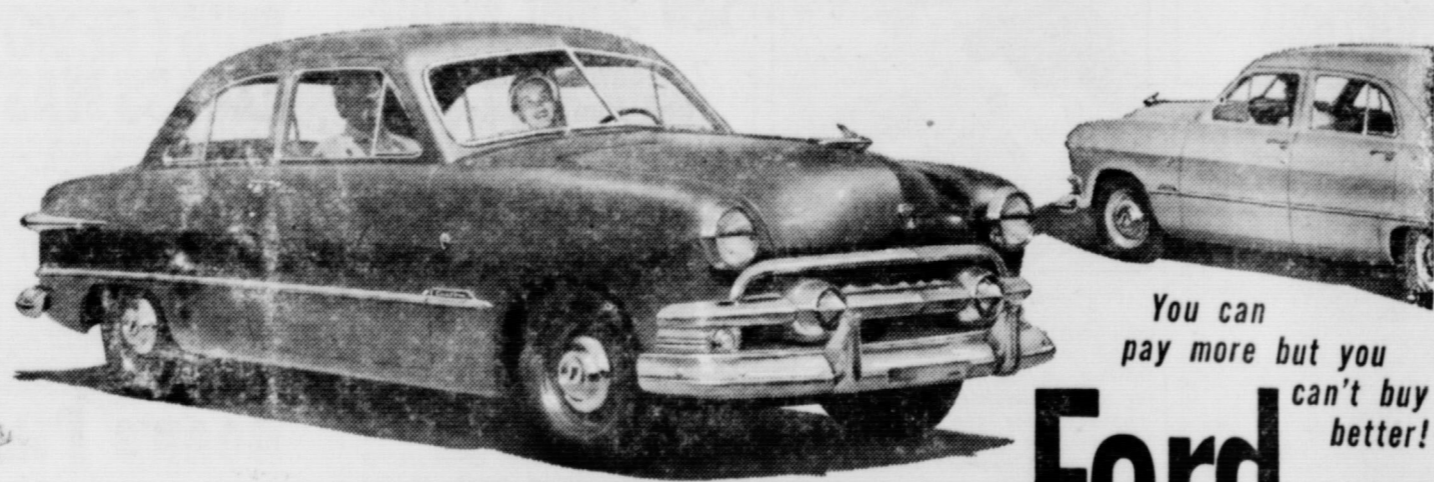

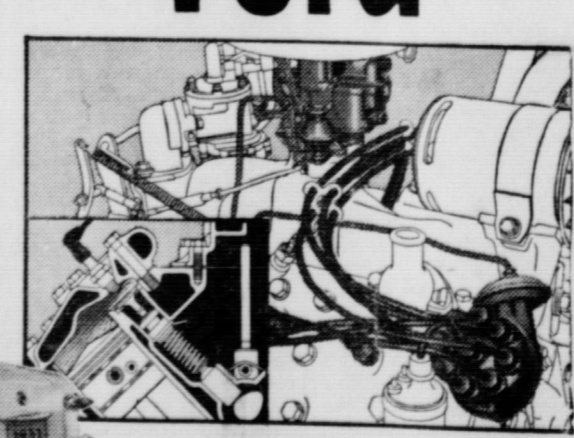

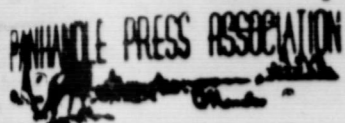

create the terrific sickness at the
 stomach known as food poisoning
 are usually brewed up in such
 foods as cream puffs, eclairs, salad
 dressing, gravy, cold meat or dairy
 products that have been too long
 away from refrigeration. They hit
 suddenly about three hours after
 eating, usually with a strange feel-
 ing of excessive watering of the
 mouth, then the vomiting and
 diarrhea following closely and per-
 sist along with stomach cramps
 for the next 24 hours.

Staph food poisoning strikes the
 quickest, lays you out the fastest,
 and lets go of you the soonest of
 any of the brands of food poisoning.
 A very similar type, called sal-
 monella food poisoning, is actually
 an irritation of the digestive tract
 caused by germ growth in the food.
 Spoiled meat is the most common
 food to cause salmonella food
 poisoning.

Salmonella takes longer than
 staph to get started and nearly al-
 ways creates a fever which is not
 present with staph food poisoning.
 It takes from 12 to 24 hours for
 salmonella food poisoning to
 make you wretched; it usually
 starts up with a cold chill, follow-
 ed by a bad headache, and then the
 vomiting and diarrhea.

poisoning, is the very dangerous
 type that originates usually with
 improperly canned food. Staph
 and salmonella food poisoning rarely
 ever cause death, though the per-
 son suffering from them is usu-
 ally sure he is going to die. Botu-
 lism is frequently fatal; it takes
 longer to start working and may
 just be a collapsing kind of sickness
 without the upset stomach.

Household Hints

Quilted coverlets are precious possessions and need to be washed and dried with care. The sagging weight of a wet coverlet causes uneven drying on the line and distorts its shape. If you haven't an automatic gas dryer, borrow the use of one for drying your coverlets. Set the dial at high temperature to completely dry for 20 to 25 minutes and the coverlet will be soft, fluffy and perfectly shaped.

Grease may splash onto the wall behind your range. Cut a sheet of plastic to fasten on the wall. Then a quick wipe with a soap cloth will keep it clean.

Machine oil may be removed by touching the spots while fresh with chloroform or ether.

If you have a dish drainer or other utensil with legs that scrape or are rusty, try putting a rubber eraser (taken from a pencil) on the legs.
