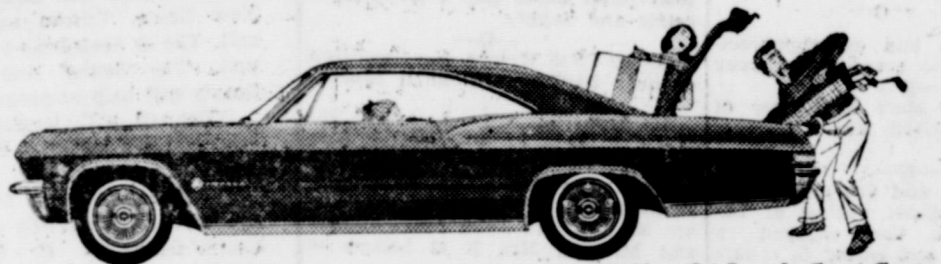

The Internal Revenue Service has prepared a free booklet of tax advice for farmers. Called "Farmer's Tax Guide," it is available from county agriculture agents or the nearest Internal Revenue Office.

Mr. John J. Sloan, Administrative Officer of the Lubbock office of Internal Revenue said the booklet is written in non-technical language and contains numerous examples showing how tax rules apply in actual situations. A sample filled-in return form is included.

Most of the high schools are teaching some of their students how to prepare better tax returns. Within the next few days some 235,000 students in Texas will have completed the short course in how to prepare an income tax return furnished the schools by Internal Revenue. If you would like to learn more about how to prepare your income tax return, get a copy of "Your Federal Income Tax," price 50c from the Internal Revenue Service office. This booklet contains a sample tax form and 159 pages of simple explanation of what to do about your common every day tax problems. The tax folks try hard to help you do a better job on your tax return. Most of us admit that we need help.

**DROPOUT PROBLEM IS OF

Although this alarming number is

rate of dropout has dropped from 41
percent to 30 percent since 1950.

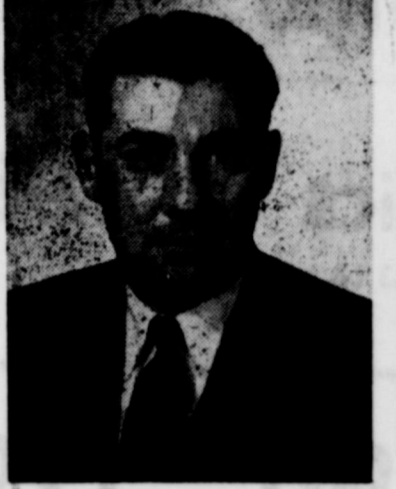

Business Backs 4-H Clubs Nation-Wide

**Incentives Help
Make Best Better**

U.S. business firms contrib-
uted \$1.25 million in 1963 toward
recognition and encouragement
of the nation's 2,225,000 4-H
Club members, the director of
the National 4-H Service Com-
mittee has announced.

Norman C. Mindrum, direc-
tor of the committee, said the
record figure made possible
awarding of college scholar-
ships and fellowships valued at
\$145,000. They were presented
this year to 275 of the nation's
most outstanding 4-H youths
and to young adults who once
were 4-H'ers.

The financial support also
was used for more than 190,000
other awards to members of
the nation's more than 94,000
local 4-H Clubs. The clubs are
in about 3,100 counties in all
50 states and Puerto Rico.

The national committee, head-
quartered in Chicago, utilizes
the funds to assist the Cooper-
ative Extension Service ad-
vance the 4-H program.

Awards Since 1900

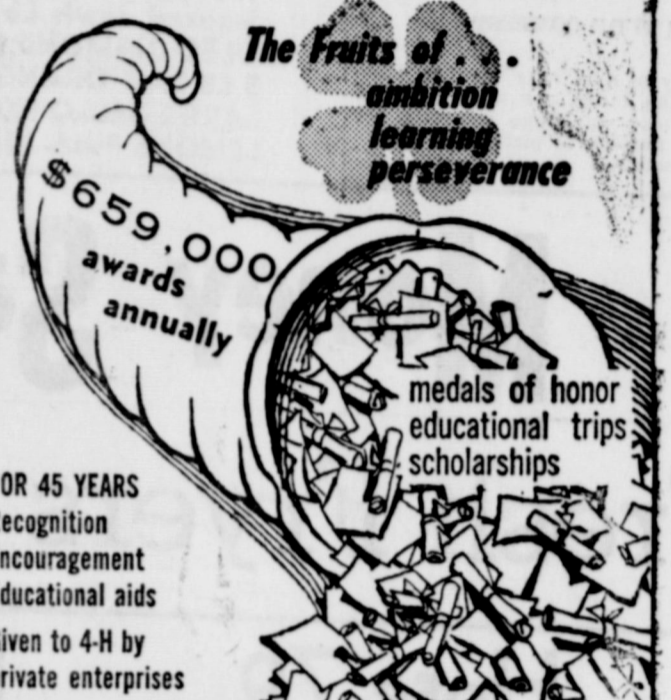
"Awards are an integral part
of 4-H," Mindrum said, "and
have been provided as incen-
tives and recognition for young
people since the early 1900s."

Help from 57 business firms
now backing 4-H dates back in
some cases to the 1920s. The
average tenure for all donors is
18 years.

The scholarships, nearly all
for \$500 each, were awarded
Dec. 1-5 during the 42nd National
4-H Club Congress in
Chicago, attended by more than
1,500 delegates. Their expense-
paid trips, considered both edu-
cational and cultural, were
awarded by more than 30 of
these firms.

Funds for programs ranging
from bread baking to entomol-
ogy are channeled through the
4-H committee, incorporated in

1923 when a handful of busi-

In the last 10 years alone, the
number of county medals
awarded has increased from

"Each donor has an interest

tion of the need for youth de-
velopment and a feeling that
the organization can serve 4-H
in a wholesome manner with
limited self-gain," Mindrum
said.

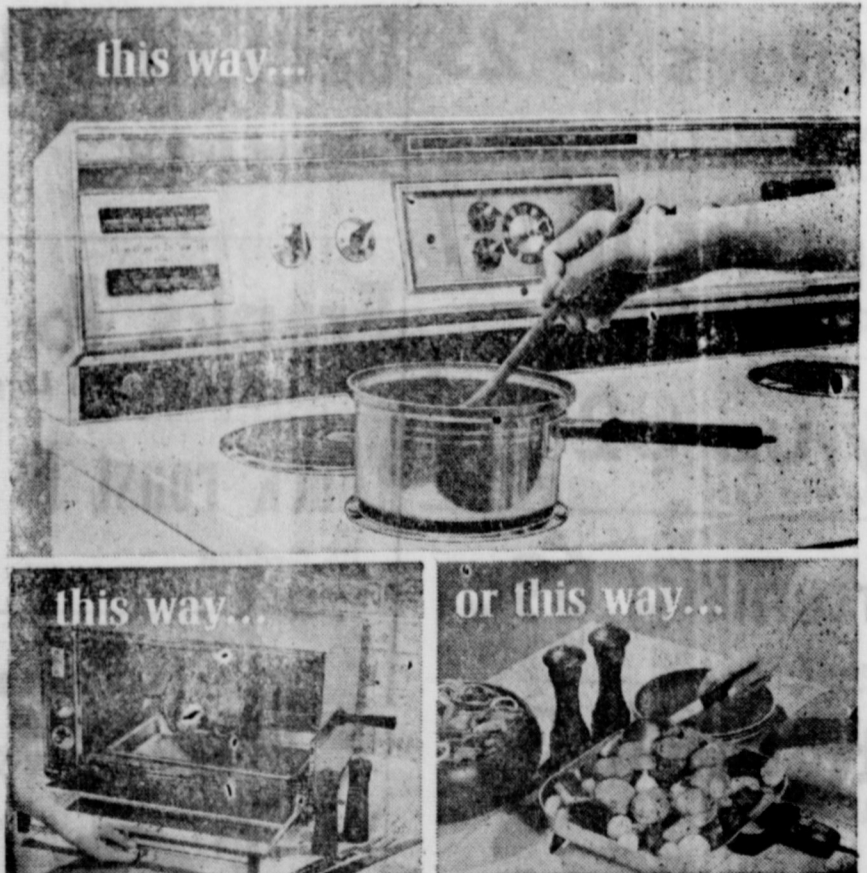
