Be careful not to damage the interior of the seed. <br> Remove the tough outer shell of abronia (sand verbena,) castor bean, nasturtium, and momordica. <br> Soak the following flower seeds in water for 12 hours: Canna lily, Job's tears, sweet pea, all morning glories, and momordica. <br> For preventing disease: <br> Soak the following vegetable seeds in hot water at exactly 122 degrees $\mathbf{F}$. for precisely $30 \mathrm{~min}-$ black leg: Broccoli, brussels sprouts, cabbage, cauliflower and |
