Cotton Babies Throng In Goldsmith, Ind.

GOLDSMITH, Ind.—Dr. S. M. Cotton was given a big day recently in this town of 300 population. He celebrated his 50th year as a "country doctor" with the aid of more than 3,000 persons.

Fifteen hundred of the celebrators wore cards on their lapels proudly proclaiming "I Am a Cotton Baby."

The slender, blue-eyed doctor thought he must have delivered "between four and five thousand" babies. Tipton county records show Cotton's name on 4,467 birth certificates.

Cotton was honored at a big dinner in the Methodist Church. Afterwards, the Jefferson Township band led a parade down Main St. to the Old Settlers' Grounds, where the doctor, his sandy hair shot with gray, presided over a picnic.

This Small Town Is Mailing Center For Rays of Cheer

CANASTOTA, N.Y.—Ma and Pa Bobb are a couple nearing their 70th birthday who live near here and consider bringing cheer to others the greatest satisfaction in life. This town is mailing center for rays of sunshine.

They send greetings, "sunshine letters," to hundreds of the bed-ridden or persons in wheel chairs, people often suffering more from loneliness and neglect than from physical ailments.

During the past nine years thousands of shut-ins have received birthday and Christmas greetings as well as letters twice a month from the Bobbs.

The letter-visits to the shut-ins were begun in 1942. At first only 50 lonely persons received letters, but the idea grew until now more than 1,400 elderly people, all with physical handicaps, hear regularly from Ma and Pa.

The Bobbs find their shut-ins by consulting through the mails with health departments and public health associations.

There is no mention in the letters to the shut-ins of wars and economic problems. They concern things like the buckwheat cakes mom used to make, the woodbox beside the kitchen stove, and the peddlers who used to come around with pins, threads, shoelaces and buttons, the old covered bridges, and other things the oldsters remember with fondness.

The oldsters know that they are not expected to reply to the "sunshine letters."

Cotton improvement groups, other than those in counties where the deadline has passed, are urged to apply now for free Smith-Dexey cotton classification and market news services this year. The deadline for filing for these services is Aug. 1st. Instructions and applications are available from county agricultural agents.

Most areas of the state have enjoyed good rains, but good range grasses need help to stage a comeback. For more information, ask your local county agent for a publication on Deferred and Rotation grazing.

Curves Eliminated Between N. C. Towns

OLD FORT, N.C.—The re-location of a road between here and Ridgecrest is taking the hairpins out of a mountain trail, but the job itself is a hair-raising one.

With an army of bulldozers, tractors, trucks and other earth-moving machines, construction crews are making war against a mountain. In jeeps that scamper over ravines, like mountain goats, engineers direct the operation by radio-telephone.

The road-building project is based on the "leveling off" principle, which means filling in the valleys, as well as cutting through the hills. And in making the necessary "fills" and "cuts," workers must cope with the movement of millions of cubic yards of stone and soil, frequently working at angles that defy the law of gravity.

In the words of one engineer, "The project would be next to impossible were it not for jeeps, which we use for operating in all advanced positions, and for the many trips we must make to and from the field office." The radio-telephone system of communications was also rated as "vitality essential."

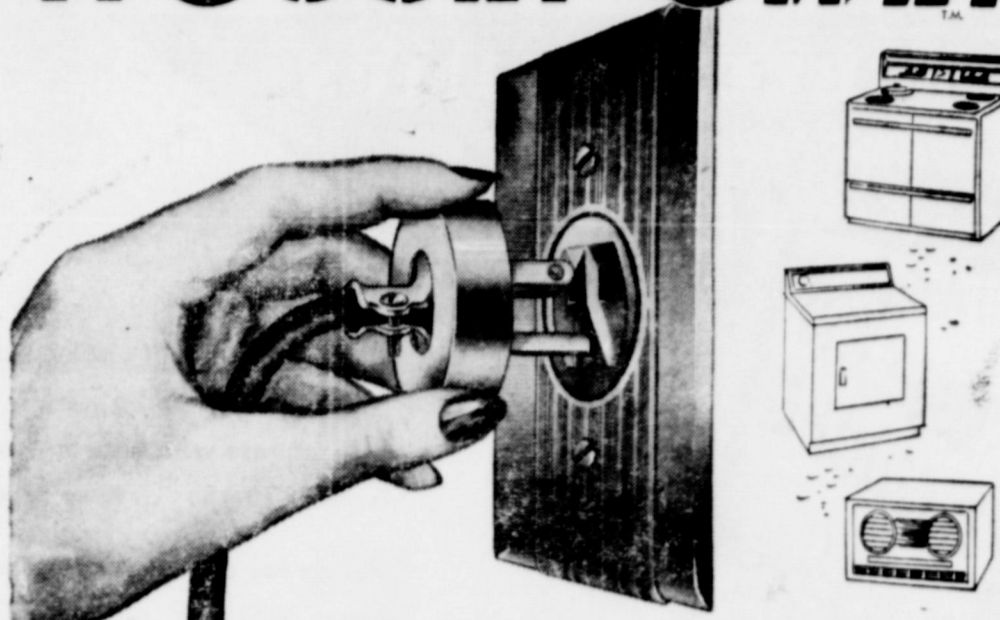
When completed this fall, the new road will replace an eight-mile section of U.S. 70, which has 98 dangerous curves and a bad accident record. The new highway will have two 22-foot lanes, no hazardous bends, only 19 curves of the easy-to-take variety, and it will reduce the overall traveling distance by a good two miles under the old route.

The construction firm of W. E. Graham & Sons, Cleveland, N.C., called the road re-location project the biggest ever undertaken on this side of the Mississippi. Pointed out, too, was the fact that the new road will have 10-foot shoulders and a drainage system utilizing heavy-duty culverts up to 54 inches.

Take the advice of the Texas Farm and Ranch Safety Council and take a break from farm work in mid-morning and mid-afternoon hours. This 10 or 15 minute break from work routine will reduce accident possibility and also improve work efficiency.

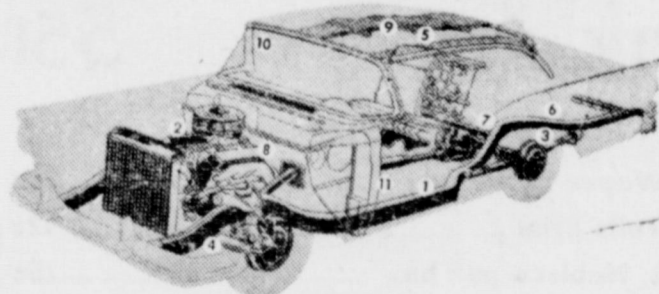

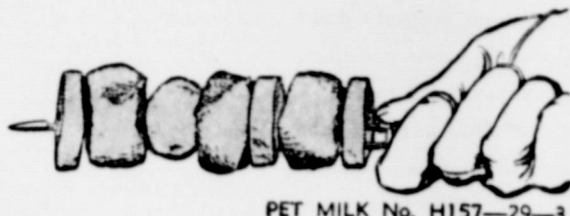
