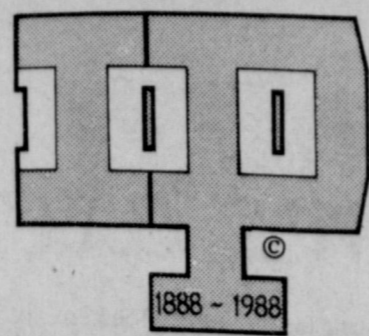

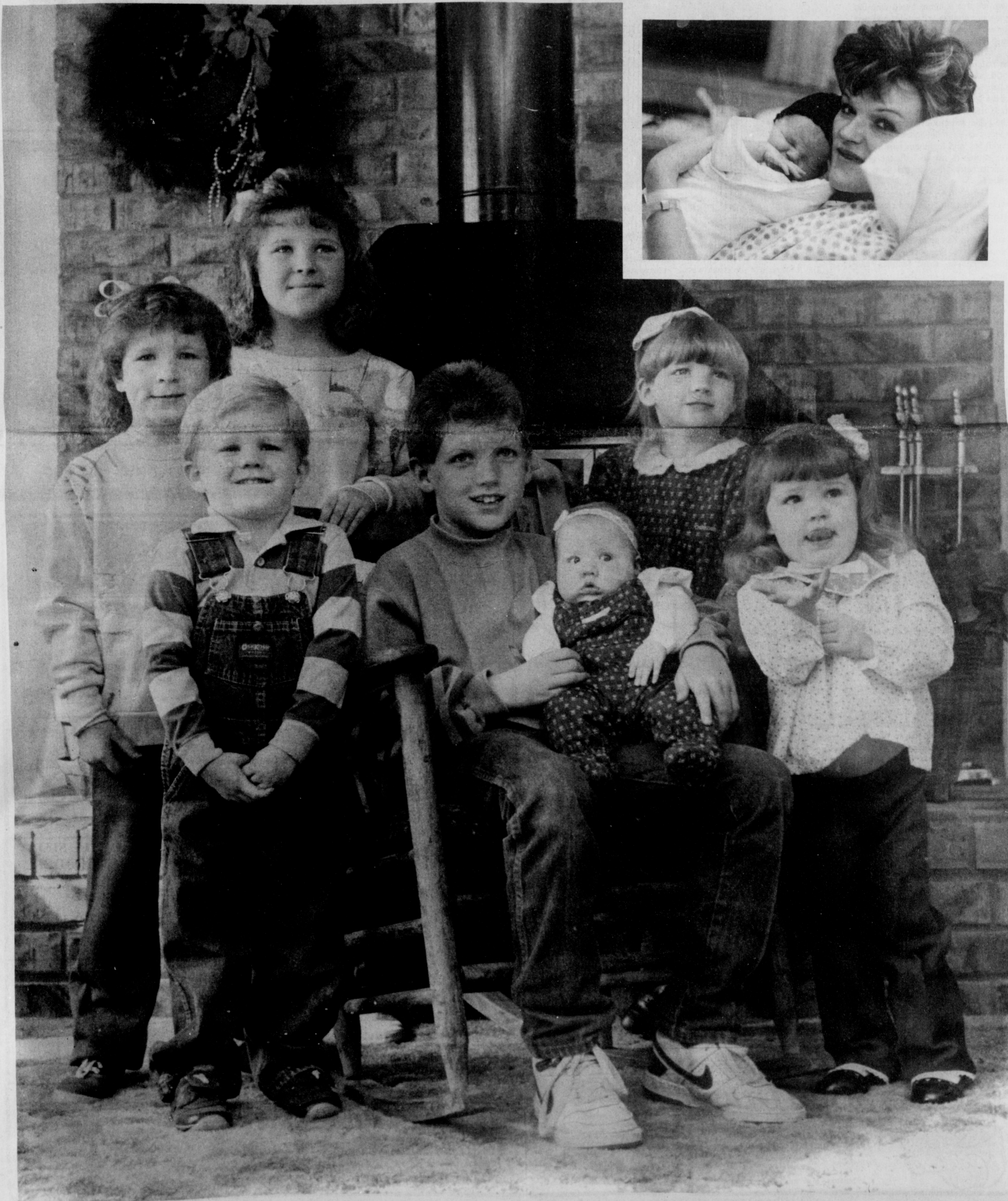

# Farnsworth, Escue wedding vows exchanged

At the invitation of Rev. and Mrs. Howell E. Farnsworth Jr. of Floydada and Mr. and Mrs. Herman Escue of Iowa Park, a host of relatives and friends assembled at the First Baptist Church in Iowa Park Friday evening to witness the solemn recitation of marriage vows by their children, Holly Beth Farnsworth and Terry Lee Escue.

The bride's father, a former pastor of the church, was assisted by Bill Bates in officiating the double-ring ceremony, which was performed in a setting illuminated by an abundance of cathedral candles in an archway decorated with spathiphyllum and diffenbachia greenery flanked by spiral candelabrum trimmed in harmonizing style. The decorative pattern was accentuated by two tall tree columns based with the greenery at altar extremities and two lower columns on either side of the step leading to the altar.

The unity candlestick dedicated to holding the unity candle that the bride and groom light to seal their vows was decorated with gypsophila and a white satin bow with satin and lace cascading ribbons. The parents of the bride and groom light the two outer candles in the holder before the ceremony and left them burning for the couple to use to light the unity candle before they exited from the church.

The church pews were marked with white satin bows and cascading greenery.

The impressive wedding music will always be one of the most vivid memories of the occasion for the bridal couple, their families and guests.

Mrs. Lee Nielsen of Wichita Falls, grandmother of the groom, was the organist and presented a pre-nuptial concert. Included in her offerings were "Fountain Reverie," "Massenet's Meditation," a meditation of "Savior, Like a Shepherd Lead Us" and "There Is No Greater Love." She accompanied Clay Morgan for his hand bells rendition of "Oh Perfect Love" for a prelude number.

The organist played "Trumpet Voluntary" for members of the wedding party to take their places in the nuptial space, then swelled the strains to signal for wedding guests to stand as the bride and her father approached the altar.

After Rev. Farnsworth answered "Her mother and I" to Bill Bates' question "Who giveth this woman in marriage?" the bride's father was in charge of directing the exchange of wedding vows and rings. A special feature of the ceremony was the groom's solo "Only God Could Love You More" sung to the bride.

During the ceremony, Buddy Mercer and Tina Escue, sister of the groom, sang "Household of Faith," and they sang "The Lord's Prayer" at the close. The music was concluded with the organist playing Rodger's "Wedding Recessional."

Tradition and beauty were artfully intermingled in the ivory satin and French alencon lace gown designed by Zurc for the Princess Collection the bride chose for her wedding. The scalloped sweetheart neckline of the gown led to gently puffed satin and tulle waistlength sleeves, and the fitted bodice fell to a

basque waistline. The skirt and chapel train were lavishly trimmed with alencon lace appliques.

The loveliness of the gown was enhanced with a headpiece caplet of pearls, sequins and satin leaves accented with a pouf of illusion at the back from which her matching veil fell softly to fingertip length. The bride's cascade bouquet of fresh peach and white roses, starburst mums, baby's breath and asparagus fern added a perfect touch to the bridal costume.

In observing bridal traditions, she carried an antique handkerchief that belonged to Mrs. H.E. Farnsworth Sr. of Dallas, her paternal grandmother, for "something old," and wore "something borrowed" pearls from her maternal grandmother, Mrs. Loyd Tate of Dallas. She chose her exquisite gown for "something new" and a garter for "something blue."

Miss Angela Hobbs of Lubbock participated in the wedding as maid of honor. The bridesmaids were Mrs. Phillip Farnsworth of Wichita Falls, sister-in-law of the bride, Miss Paula Spencer of Lubbock, Miss Cindy Harper and Miss Gina Lee Weaver, both of Iowa Park. They were gowned identically in teal blue moire taffeta dresses fashioned with tight bodices and short puffed sleeves, and each carried a single white rose with matching streamers.

The groom, male members of the wedding party, fathers of the bride and groom, and Bill Bates, the assisting officiant, wore black tuxedos with matching cummerbunds and ties and white shirts. The groom distinguished his apparel with a peach rose boutonniere and the others wore white rose boutonnieres.

the tables in the setting attracted attention of the guests as they entered the room. The floor length cloths were laid over ivory satin and headed with garlands of grapeleaf ivy.

A tiered flounce of lace underneath the greenery added distinction to the bride's cloth, and the spectacular Lady Windemere cake captured the elegance of her table. In design, the four satellite cakes supported a two-tier top, each decorated with peach roses in a cream icing. The roses graced the cake at each lacy valance and topped it with a crown of the cascading flowers.

A bouquet of fresh peach and white roses, starburst mums, baby's breath and asparagus fern, the silver punch service, crystal and silver serving dishes, and white napkins engraved with "Holly-Terry, December 16, 1988" in black enhanced the table's appeal.

The groom's table was centered with a large bouquet of the flowers used in the bouquet on the bride's table flanked by tall white candles in silver holders. The sides were marked with a Black Forest cake ordered from Ridglea Country Club in Fort Worth and a crystal punch service.

The silver coffee urn, cups and saucers were placed on a small round table, and the long gift table was centered with a doll bride in her wedding gown.

Miss Cynthia Hobbs of Waco directed signatures of wedding guests in the church foyer before the wedding and at the reception.

The reception assistants were Miss Wresha Rhoderick, Miss Penny Belt, Mmes. Larry Belt, Carey Hobbs and Gilbert Davis. Leeann Tate handed out the ivory lace rice bags tied with teal blue ribbon.

Mr. and Mrs. Herman Escue, the groom's parents, hosted the rehearsal dinner on the eve of the wedding at the church.

Mrs. Carey Hobbs, Misses Linda and Cindy Hobbs were hostesses for a bridesmaids luncheon Friday at the University Club in Wichita Falls.

Special wedding guests were Mmes. H.E. Farnsworth Sr. and Mrs. Loyd Tate of Dallas, grandmothers of the bride, Mrs. C.M. Escue of Iowa Park and Mrs.

Lee Nielsen of Wichita Falls, grandmothers of the groom.

Out-of-town wedding guests included Messrs. and Mmes. Carey Hobbs and family from Waco, Jess Farnsworth and sons of Duncanville, Gilbert Davis of Rowlett, Larry Belt and Crandle Davis of Mesquite, Mike Miller of Galveston, Dan Murphy of Dayton and Kenneth Escue of Garland, Mrs. Tommy Mercer of Megargel, Mrs. Ted Heers of Kilgore, Howard Escue of Galveston and Buddy Tate, Lee Ann and John of Dallas.

The bride and groom were graduated from Iowa Park High School. She is a senior at Texas

Tech Univ., and he holds a B.A. degree from Midwestern State Univ. After a short wedding trip where the bride travelled in a two-piece cashmere sweater ensemble, the couple will live at Lubbock.

Clara watched in awe as the mice returned and began to battle with the soldiers. The Nutcracker came to life and took command of the remaining

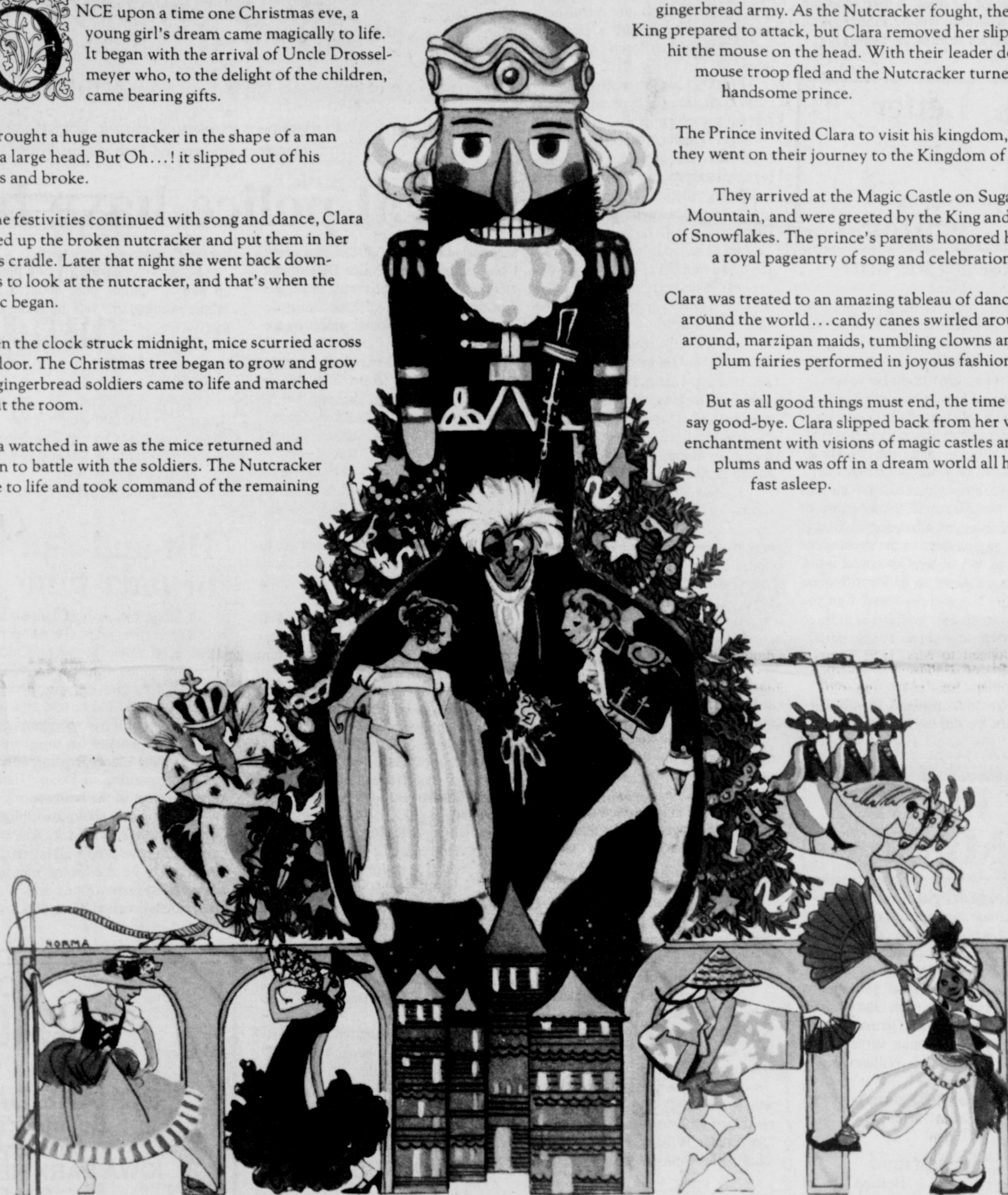

## Trash pickup scheduled

Leading up to the Christmas holidays, some changes are being made this week in the city's trash collection routes and schedules, according to Mike Price, public works director.

Wednesday's routes were collected on their normal schedule, along with the Thursday route south of the railroad tracks to Garden Valley.

Today's route, which is the eastern portion of the north half of town, and Garden Valley, will be collected at their normal time, along with all routes normally collected on Friday mornings.

Friday's route will be the routes normally collected on Saturday, along with all the single-family roll-outs normally collected on Friday afternoon.

No pickups will be made on Saturday, Price said.

All routes will return to their normal collection time beginning Monday morning.

The Landfill will be closed to the public beginning Friday, through Monday.

For those wishing to dispose of their Christmas trees, Price said they

can be placed in the alleys next to the dumpsters, or on the front curb of homes without alleys, and the city will pick them up.

Plans are being made to have a bonfire around New Year's Eve, to dispose of the trees. A time schedule for the burning will be announced in next week's issue of the Leader.

## Local police have busy week

Major entries of the past week on the Iowa Park Police Department blotter include three thefts, three acts of criminal mischief, three arrests on warrants, two accidents and one case of forgery.

One of the thefts, a money bag containing \$261 from The Movie Store, was reported Tuesday. While the theft was alleged to have occurred during hours the business was closed, there were no signs of forced entry.

A boat valued at \$400 was reported Saturday as having been taken from the back yard at 409 W. Washington.

The third theft was reported to police Monday, involving chrome rings from the driver's side of a Blazer.

B&R Thriftway told police Friday of a forged check in the amount of \$100. Police have issued a warrant on a female suspect, Beverly Morgan Rodriguez of Electra, who reportedly is already in county jail on another forgery charge.

Criminal mischief reports include theft of a hood ornament in the 100 block of Hope Lane, an object being thrown through an apartment window at 1001 Johnson, and the back window of a van being shattered in the 1300 block of Westridge.

Two of the arrests for outstanding warrants were made within a three-hour period Friday evening.

Michael Basham, 20, was taken into custody at 9:47 p.m. on local traffic warrants, and Carl Robertson, 41, was arrested at 10:13 on warrants issued by the Department of Public Safety.

Basham was released after posting his bond, but Robertson was transported to county jail.

Steven Ray Harrison, 26, was arrested Friday evening on DPS warrants, and transported to county jail.

Police have issued a warrant for William Perry Roberts, 55, for driv-

ing while license is suspended.

Roberts reportedly drove his pickup into a highline pole about 8:30 Friday evening, and left the scene on foot.

The other accident worked by police occurred at 5:40 p.m. Tuesday at 701 S. Wall.

Steven Dale Fisher, 29, was attempting to turn into the driveway at that address when he was struck by a motorcycle driven by Tommy Wayne Fowler, 20, of 403 W. Poe.

Impact, according to the police

report, was when the Fisher vehicle's right front wheel was two feet inside the center stripe.

The vehicles traveled another 52 feet, into Fisher's yard, but Fowler was thrown into the ditch midway between the impact point and where the two vehicles came to rest.

Fisher and Fowler were both transported to a Wichita Falls hospital by ambulance.

Fisher was treated and released. Fowler suffered multiple injuries, including a broken leg.

## Hit-and-run victim worked at part-time job in Iowa Park

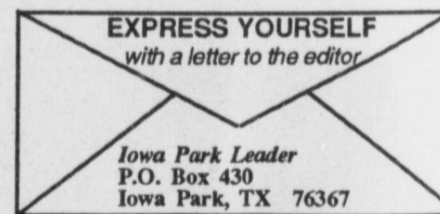
A Holliday man was killed early Monday morning by a hit and run driver in Holliday shortly after he left his part time job in Iowa Park.

Glenn Austin, 19, was apparently struck and killed on the highway in Holliday about 3 in the morning. He had punched his time card at the Good and Plenty Restaurant here at 2:45, according to Donny Hodgkins, co-owner of the business.

Austin lives about two blocks from Allsup's in Holliday, and was believed to have been walking to that business, as he did every morning when he got home from work, when the accident occurred, Hodgkins said.

A truck driver found the body in the eastbound side of the road and notified Holliday authorities.

Hodgkins said Austin works at a business in Wichita Falls from 11 a.m. to 10 p.m., and then cleans up the Iowa Park business before going home.

went to the dressing room at halftime with a 23-10 advantage.

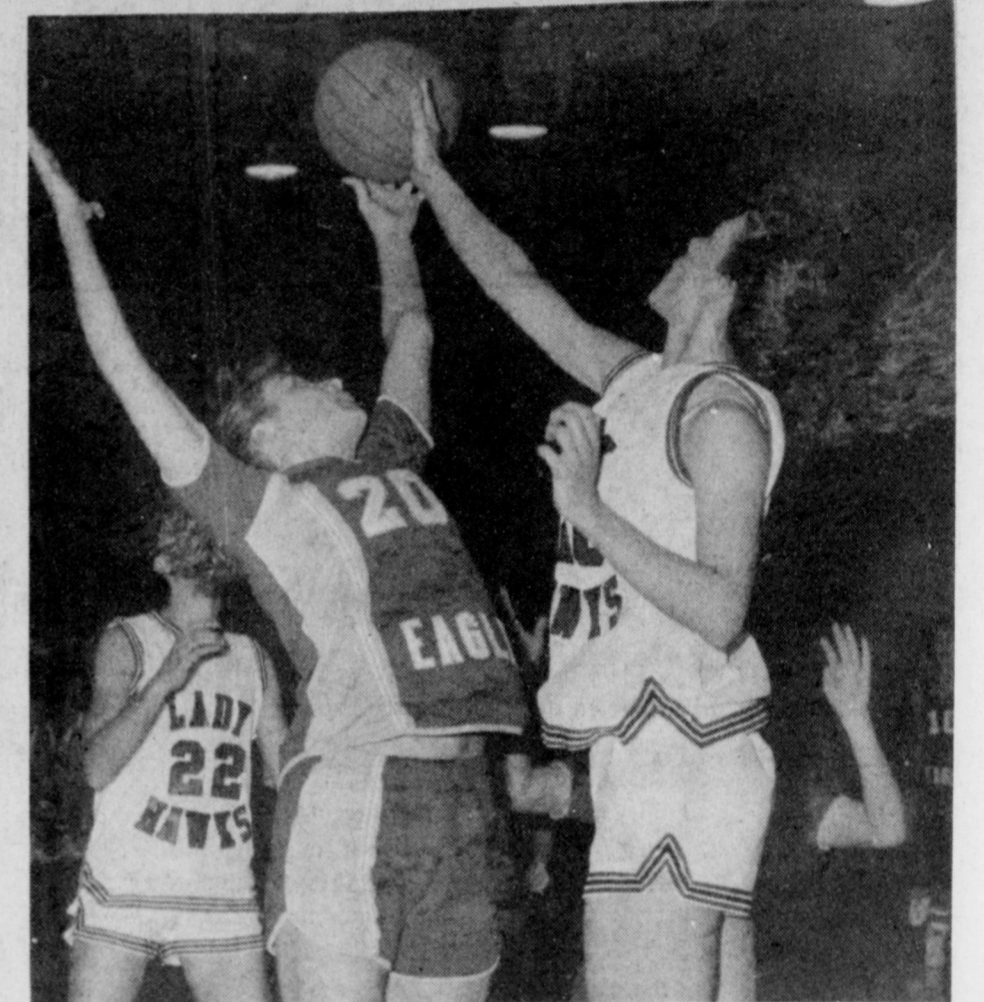
They maintained a 31-19 lead going into the final stanza.

Kerri Dörner had her season high against Holliday, racking up 16 points. Angie Turner followed with eight.

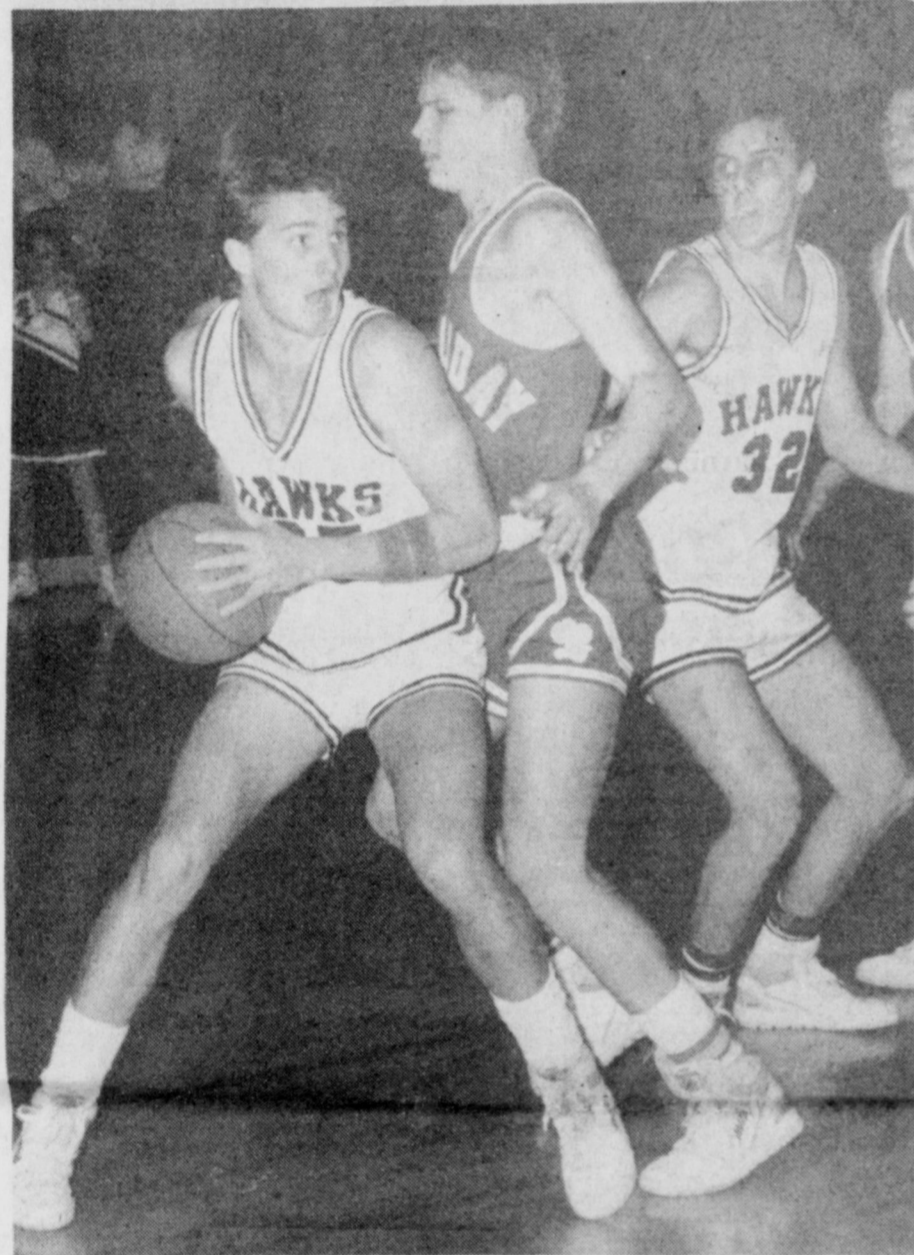
