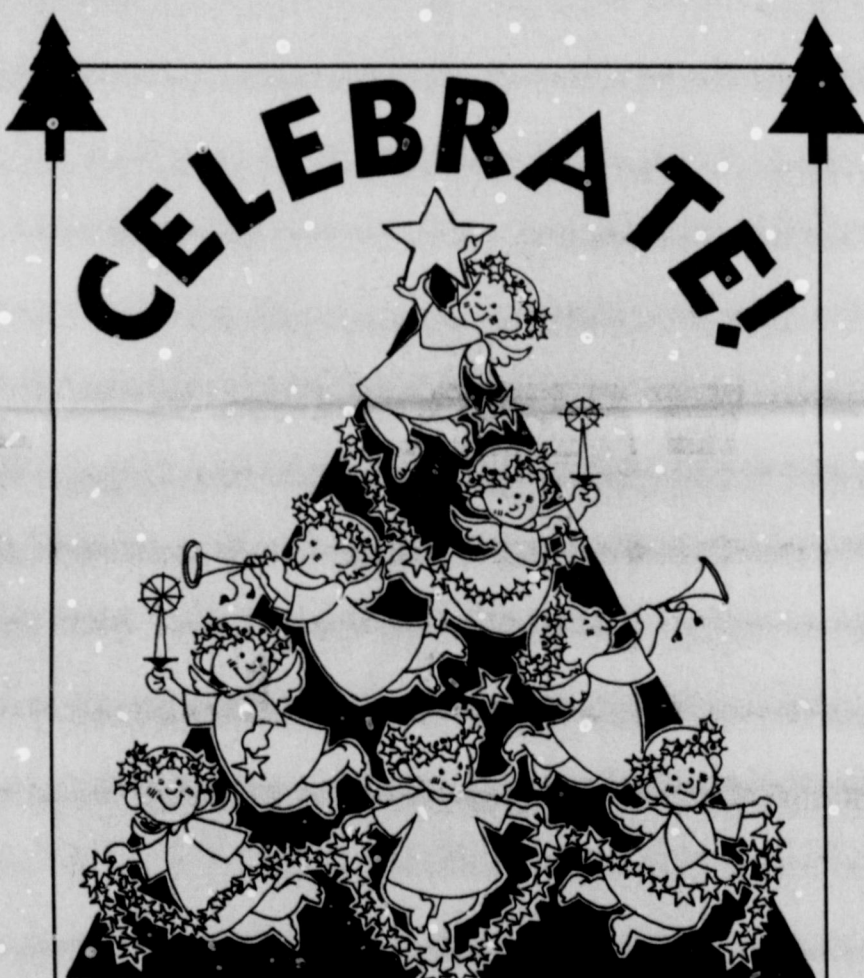

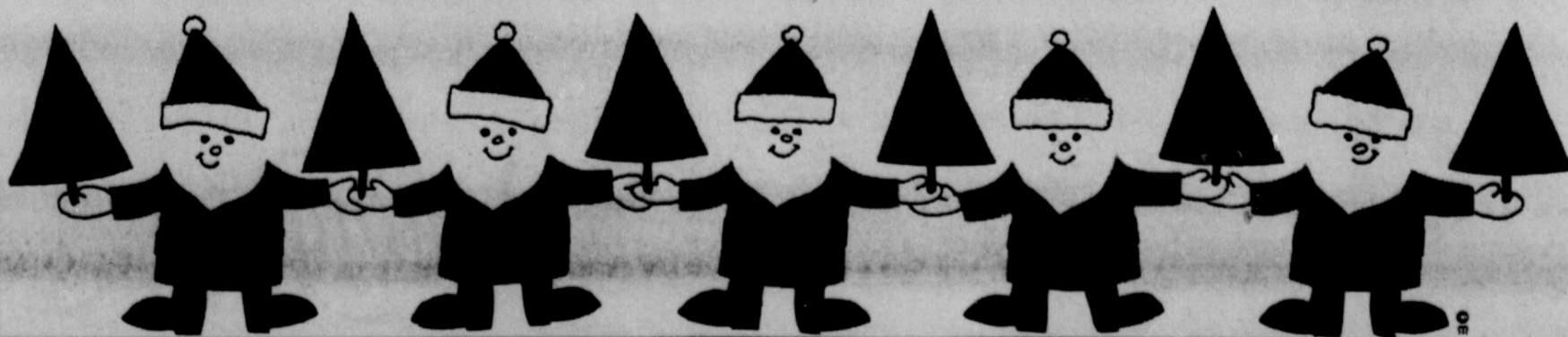

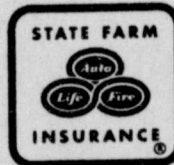

THE TWELVE DAYS OF CHRISTMAS



Did you know that the "Twelve Days of Christmas" come *after* Christmas? The day after Christmas has become the second biggest and busiest shopping day of the year -- after the Friday after Thanksgiving. People take advantage of the day to return all the things that didn't fit or those they didn't want. Unfortunately, we Christians have allowed store managers to define our Christmas Season for us.

Contrary to these practices, the Church invites us to celebrate a season that begins, rather than ends, on Christmas Day. In the Church's calendar the Christmas season begins with the evening celebration of Mass (ChristMass) on Christmas Eve, continues through New Year's Day and the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord on the Sunday after Epiphany. It is a time of great joy, during which we celebrate the wonder of Jesus' birth and reflect on the nearness of God's love. Like the angels, we are called to be heralds of the good news that a saving God comes to dwell among us. Like the Three Kings, we offer our gifts to the Lord.

Sometimes it may seem that our Christmas celebrations are out of step with the rest of the world around us. While most people are putting away their Christmas music, by this time, the decor and music of our worship services ring out the good news of the birth of Jesus and His repeated manifestations to the world.

During this season we celebrate the light of God's love revealed in the new dawn of Jesus' birth. But the birth of Jesus was not officially celebrated on December 25 until the fourth century. Up until then, December 25 was the date for the pagan feast of the returning sun, the winter solstice, when the days begin to grow longer again. Thus it was a festival of lights.

The Catholic Church chose this Christmas date to counteract the vestiges of pagan sun worship, proclaiming God as the one true light. Many of the symbols and customs we keep at Christmas actually come from the various pagan celebration of light that predate it. These include lights on our tree, candles in our windows, the Yule log in our hearths. From our perspective, we recognize that all these traditions remind us of Jesus, the true light who came into the world to overcome the darkness of sin.

May the peace of Christ rule in your hearts and the fullness of his message live within you. Merry Christmas!

Robertson promoted

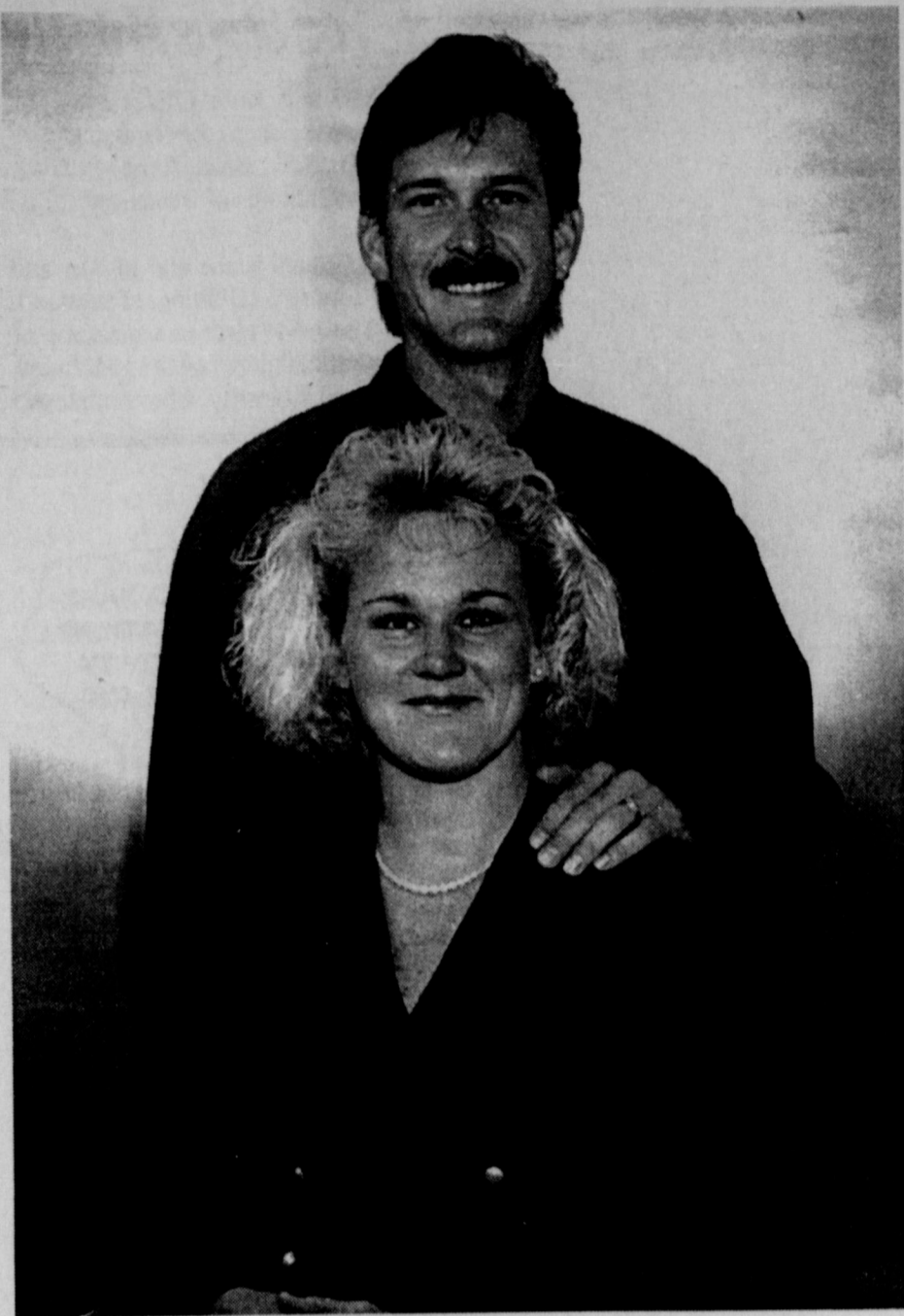
Marvin Robertson has been promoted to the position of training superintendent of the Iowa Park Cryovac plant.

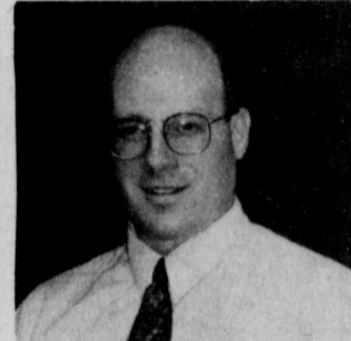

They met at North Texas State Teachers College, (now University of North Texas) at Denton, and were married Dec. 25, 1934 in Cisco.

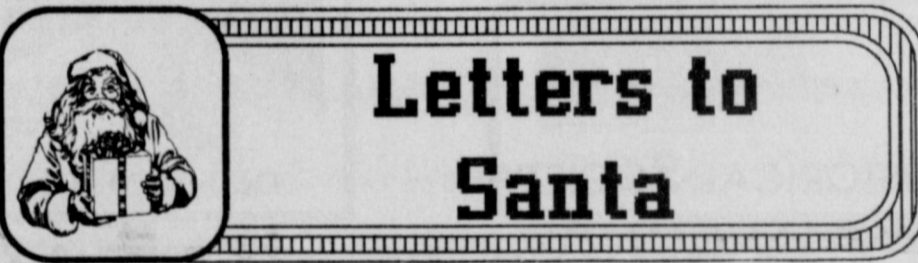
Following Butts' graduation from college, he taught school and was basketball coach at Covington.

City pulling money out of state's fund

Though no official action was taken during Monday night's meeting of the city council, the outset was that Iowa Park's money will be pulled from Tex-Pool and deposited in a local bank.

Aldermen generally agreed that the mayor had the authority to move deposits from one depository to another without a vote by the council, as long as those investments were backed by collateral.

Mayor Wayne House expressed concern that a "run" on the state-sponsored interest-bearing depository called Tex-Pool, which has been widely reported the past couple of weeks, could possibly leave that fund unable to return the city's monies.

Several billion dollars invested in Tex-Pool by cities, counties and schools across the state have been withdrawn following a story that appeared in a recent issue of the *Wall Street Journal*, which linked Tex-Pool investments similar to those of California's Orange County.

The mayor said money in Tex-Pool is not backed by the State of Texas, even though it is operated by the state, because no legislative action has ever been taken.

House also pointed out that State National Bank had offered to pay a higher interest rate than the 4.83-percent rate Tex-Pool was paying on monies deposited.

As of Dec. 14, the city had various accounts deposited in Tex-Pool that totaled \$624,059. Additionally, House said approximately \$300,000 of recently-received tax money was on hand in State National, awaiting a decision by the council.

Besides the fact that State National is offering a higher interest rate than Tex-Pool, House added that he preferred doing business with local businesses.

The city began using Tex-Pool for its liquid funds several years ago, during the time when James Barrington was city administrator, because it was offering a higher interest than could be obtained locally.

OTHER BUSINESS

In other business, the council gave its stamp of approval to development of another housing addition, granted a waiver to an individual, accepted a construction bid, approved a list of fees to be charged when city equipment is used on private property, and decided to get out of a home-assistance program.

A housing development with some 200 lots in the northeast part of the city to be built by David Parkey and Kenneth Beall was approved by the council, after having been okayed by the Planning and Zoning Board.

Though the development has an "R-2" zoning code, to permit smaller, less-expensive homes, the council was assured no mobile homes would be allowed in the area.

Following a public appearance by Bo Watson, a representative of the Edward D. Jones & Co. investment firm, aldermen approved a temporary waiver for Watson to make house-to-house calls.

Watson, who explained he wished to open an office here but initially wanted to make house calls expressly to introduce himself to the public, was given the waiver until the council's first meeting in January, when the subject will again be reviewed.

Jalyn Construction Co. submitted the lowest of three bids to construct a sewer line along the north access road from property owned by the Industrial Development Corporation eastward to FM 368.

The company's bid was \$26,839. A list of fees was approved to be charged whenever city-owned equip-

ment and personnel are used to do any work on private property, such as parking lots, driveways, mowing, etc.

Three of the topics on Monday's meeting agenda were concerned with the 1993 HOME Program Homebuyer plan. The council had previously voted approval of one phase, which was to enter the program.

However, aldermen expressed the concern that they had earlier approved the program and were now learning how extensive it would be on city staff, as well as a fear of mounting government intrusion in local activities, decided to withdraw from participation.

Only four inquiries had been received from prospective participants, it was pointed out. Under the plan, they would have been able to move into a new home and become its owner after five years, and not had to make any payments.

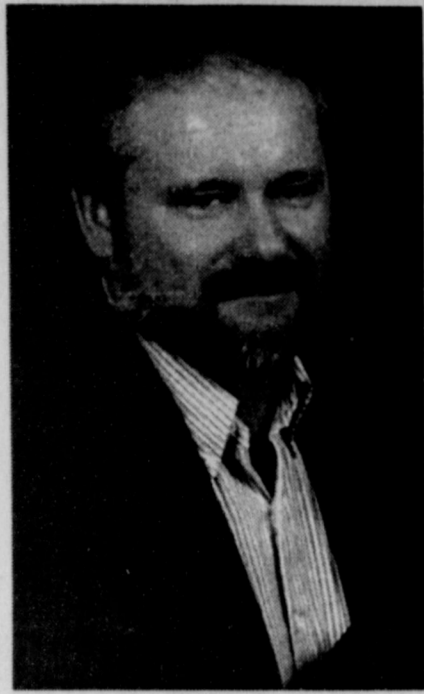


