Public Schools Week In Texas General Information SUBJECT: Public Schools Week in Texas. DATE: March 5.March 9, 1962
OBJECTIVE: To acquaint all our people with programs and accomplish ments of our public education systems.

THOUGHT: Our forefathers in their wisdom, recognizing the importance
of education in the function and operation of a democracy, establish
ed the public school to make education available to all. The people
ed the public school to make education available to all. The people
of Texas declared, by the expressed terms of State Constifution, "a general diffusion of knowledge being essential to the presevvation of the liberties and right of the people, it shall be the duty
of the Legislature of the State to establish and make suitable pro of the Legislature of the State to establish and make suitable pro-
vision for the support and maintenance of an efficient system of public free schools." The 1854 School Law provided for the first Public School System in Texas. As the years passed our laws were strengthened to make sure that all children of a school age shared in this opportunity for public education. Today the importance of education is not a debatable subject. Our job is to see that children of this generation get the best possible education we can give them. By visiting the schools and familiarizing ourselves with the problems of
teachers and students, we become more competent to safegurd advance the institution that is so American-the public school.
