

Holiday Customs Vary

What does Christmas evoke for you? That depends on what part of the world you come from, or what part of the world your people originated from.

In the Old World, customs

varied from country to country, each one charming in its own way. In Austria, for instance, emphasis was placed upon light as the symbol of Christ, the light of the world. Accordingly, in each Austrian home, three large wax candles would be specially prepared for a lovely ritual held in the home on Christmas Eve. With the family gathered around, the father of the household would light the first candle with a burning taper, all the while chanting, "Christ is born, Christ is born." Each member of the family would take the taper in turn, repeating, "Praised be the Lord! Christ is born!" On Christmas Day, the second candle would be lit and the third and last candle would be lit on New Year's Day, the end of the Christmas season.

In jolly old England, much of the festivities of the holidays centered around the yule log, which was traditionally brought in on Christmas Eve. Before the log was set ablaze, it was the custom for each member of the family to sit upon it and salute it with a kiss — this was to ensure good luck for the household in the coming year. Remnants of last year's yule log would be used to light the new one, while the

household sang a song of welcome to the yule season and the coming year.

Mystery plays were always staged at Christmas time in early England by "mummers" or maskers. Each region had its own play, generally a variation on the theme of St. George and the dragon

In Poland, Christmas was centered around songs, feasting and religious services. On Christmas Eve, known as the Festival of the Star, the festivities always began with the appearance of the first star in the sky. After supper, youngsters were quizzed by the "Star Man" on their catechism; wrong answers drew reproval and right answers brought rewards. Gifts were brought by three young boys dressed as the Wise Men and carrying an illuminated star, followed by young people dressed as wild animals to represent the creatures in the stable at the birth of the Infant Jesus.

In Old Spain, youngsters would don peasant costumes and dance around the nacimiento, or nativity scene, to the accompaniment of tambourines on Christmas Eve. On the eve of the feast of the Epiphany, January 6, the youngsters would wait at the city gates for the Magi, who are said to journey to Bethlehem each year, according to Spanish legend. Instead of hanging up their stockings, they would hide slippers and shoes for the Wise Men to fill with goodies
