It is that time of year when pare ourselves for sever weather in our area. Public isessential and should be known When the National Weather Service or neighboring town(s) alert us of the dangerous conditions then the Dept. Officials Fire Departments, Sheriffs Office or DPS) will deploy along Farm-to-Market roads and outside of the city limits. The adio communications, that are vital to the officials, by the weather spotter to the Department base unit is in constant contact of weather conditions; if a funnel is sighted by a spotter
then the Base Unit will activate the alarm system in the city. In the Quitaque area the ystem will be conducted one of two ways or both, that which would be by public address and or siren system. The public
address system is noted when address system is noted when Department, ambulance, Sheriff, DPS units) announce the threatening conditions to find a place of safety and to take cover. The siren system (located at the number of whistlesit sounds off. The number of whistles indicated are: Three signals indicate fire in the area and
