R. Smith, Highway Patrol supervisor of this area. These crashes resulted in no one killed and five persons injured. <br> The rural traffic accident summary for this county during the first nine months of 1973 shows a total of 39 accidents resulting in two persons killed and 18 persons injured. <br> The rural traffic accident summary for the 60 counties of the Lubbock Department of Public Sa fety Region for September 1973 shows a total of 601 accidents resulting in 24 persons killed and 364 persons injured as compared to September 1972 with 561 accidents resulting in 21 persons killed and 335 persons injured. This was 40 more accidents, three more fatalities, and 29 more injured in 1973 at the same period of time. |
