The drive which resulted in the capture o Feriana enabled the Germans almost to cut clear across the waist of Tunisia. Feriana is 14 miles from the Algerian border.

The Americans made little, if any, attempt to defend Feriana, Kasserine and Sbeitla. Rather, it was an evacuation designed to get the U.S. troops into a better defensive position. The American line now runs roughly from geria.
It was not believed likely that the Germans would attempt any additional advances imme diately

American combat teams now are being concentrated on the eastern and western side of an important pass in the mountains behind Kasserine. In front of them the Germans occu py a wide stretch of table land which is arid
treeless and almost uninhabitable. In that po sition they are within range of American ar tillery.

ans, after entering Medenine, "Verdun of the Mareth Line," were aiming at the heart of that Tunisian bulwark.
