WHEEL CHAIR AND CRUTCHES TO BE AT CITY OFFICE SOON

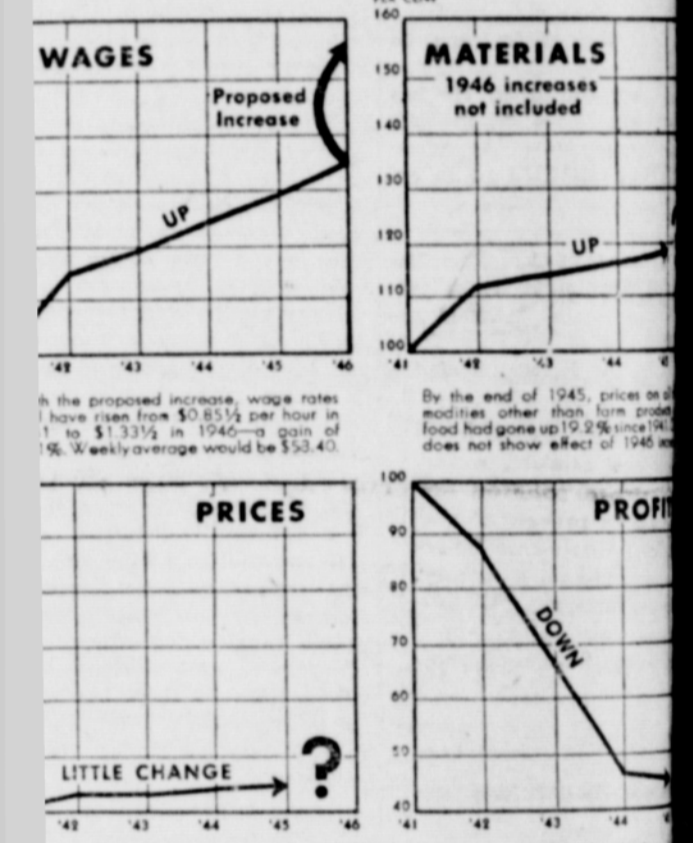
A wheel chair and pair of crutches will be on display at the City Office in a few days.

What about future profits?

The judgment of Harvester agents now is that we can make the huge wage increases recommended by the Government until the Government adequate increases in farm machinery... resulting increased costs...
