SCHOOL PROGRESSING NICELY

Supt. S. E. Settle, of the Cross Plains school reports a total enrollment in the school to date of about 260. A Parent Teachers Association has been organized and is doing nicely. He has ordered about 75 dollars worth of laboratory equipment, one hundred twenty five dollars worth of library books, for the grammar school grades, and one hundred dollars worth of maps, globes and charts. He will soon make application for 500 dollars State Aid; also the school building, in a few days, will be served with gas for heating purposes.

This amount will be materially increased, as other schools are to receive aid for the coming school term.
