Analyze intake vacuum conditions to be sure fuel mixture is being properly supplied to cylinders, valve action correct, and no manifold leakage.

Cylinder Heads: Tighten cylinder heads, intake and exhaust manifolds. Clutch Pedal: Adjust. Oil Level: Check.

Anti-Freeze: Check solution in radiator. Fan Belt. Check adjustment.

WINDSHIELD WIPERS
