A sincere "thank you" to all land owners who responded to our recent appeal for location information.

In order to uniformly value land by its productive capacity, its location must be known. Recent tax law change allows agricultural land to be valued by its productive capacity.

Texas and U.S. Dept. of Agriculture data together with data from Soil Conservation Service will be used. Also, owner-operator farm and ranch budgets from Donley County will be used.

This data will supplement the personal observation of the appraiser as he reviews each parcel of land to place typical value by its productive quality.
