# Bronco defense defuses Rockets

The Broncos are 2-0 in district play after beating Wellington 42-6 last Friday. The Skyrocket offense did not score a touchdown against the stout Bronco defense. The only Rocket score came off a fumble recovery that was run back for a touchdown.

The Bronco "D" held the Rockets to only 97-yards total offense. Chris Johnsen and Zach Butts led the Bronco defense. Johnsen had eight tackles and two interceptions, one of which he ran back for touchdown. Butts, the leading tackler on the team, had 11 tackles and 1 interception.

The Bronco defense caused the Rockets to turn the ball over 6 times in the game. The Broncos had five interceptions and a fumble recovery. Athletic Director and Head Football coach, Mark Howard, feels the defense deserves credit for their great play.

"Our defense needs to be commended for their great play. Wellington has a team that usually moves the ball up and down the field on people, and has 300 plus yards a

game. I think holding them to less than 100 yards speaks highly of our defense."

The Broncos gained 370-yards total offense. They rushed for 167-yards, led by running back Jeff Hearn, who ran for 57-yards. Colt Floyd threw for 203-yards, with one touchdown, against the Wellington defense. Sam Holton caught five passes for 122-yards on the night. Dee Thompson caught two passes for 37-yards.

The Broncos have their sights set on the Highland Park Hornets this week. The Hornets are 1-1 in district play and are coming off a win this past week. The Broncos will travel to Highland Park Friday with the game to kick-off at 7:30 p.m.

Howard is excited about playing Highland Park, but he also feels the Broncos must be ready to play.

"We feel Highland Park is very beat-able, and we feel real good going into this game. I think that we have a great chance of winning, although to win, we must play from start to finish and play the way we are capable of playing."

## District cross country meet set for Monday

The Lady Bronco and Lady Colt cross country teams competed at a cold and windy Lake Meredith meet on Saturday morning. Although there was a lot of confusion at the end of the races which led to some discrepancies in team scoring, the course was a good challenge for the athletes in their final competition before the District meet.

The Lady Broncos placed sixth as a team and had two individual medalist. April Bryley placed 15th in a time of 14:04, and Christine Holden placed 19th in a time of 14:14.

The other members of the seven lady team were Emily Sparks, 21st, 14:15; Jamie Sawyer, 31st, 14:45; Cat Chamberlain, 33rd, 14:50; Geri Butler, 37th, 14:53; and Claire Rodriguez, 38th, 14:55.

The Lady Broncos were represented by two individuals in the JV girls' race. Medalist Sarah Ray placed 16th in 15:37, and Amanda McCabe placed 31st in 17:04.

"We had a good team effort going up against some excellent teams. We'll need all of our varsity girls to move up just a few seconds faster to have a chance to advance to the Regional meet in Lubbock. And we could still show considerable improvement in this last week of the season. None of the girls have quite reached their peak yet. I think we'll surprise some people at district," said Head Girls Coach Steve Schmidt.

Lydia Hartman was the lone medalist for the Lady Colts in the Junior High division with a 17th place finish in a time of 15:09. Other members of the team were Laura Dziedzic, 44th, 16:23; Meghan Gribble, 51st, 16:40; Kayla Martindale, 57th, 16:55; Brittney Hall, 63rd, 17:04; Jessie Anderberg, 69th, 17:09; Cierra Benavidez, 71st, 17:30; and Shanna Shelton, 84th, 19:10.

The District 6-2A meet will be held on Monday, October 25, at White Deer. The varsity girls begin at 1:30 p.m. and the varsity boys begin at 2 p.m. The JV and Junior High divisions will follow these two races. The top three teams in the varsity divisions will advance to the Regional meet to be held in Lubbock.
