Beneficiaries of deceased vet-
erans who are presently receiving
insurance benefits will not be re-
quired to make application for
the special dividend.
Veterans Administration will
mail direct to beneficiaries of de-
ceased veterans whose insurance
wai not in force wat time of death,
the necessary application form
for any accrued dividend payable.
One application only is neces-
sary although the veteran may
have had more than one policy of
insurance er more than one plan
of insurance. It is further pointed
out that where the insurance
number is unknown, the veteran's
application will be identified
