citizens in every community of this country give ex-
pression to their support of the United Nations:
NOW THEREFORE, I, Major Hudson, Mayor of
Clarendon, do solemnly declare October 24th a day of
special commemoration in that it is the fifth birthday of
the organization which can maintain peace on earth
among men of good will further, I request that every
bell in this community ring out at eleven oclock on the
morning of October 24th as a reminder to every citizen
to join the rest of our country in a prayer for the success
of the United Nations in this hour of crisis; that the
citizens of Clarendon are united in support of the United
Nations and in the belief that there SHALL BE PEACE.
