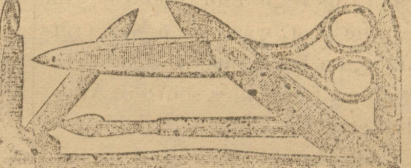

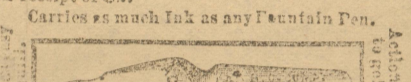

SNAKE-BIT.

On Saturday last, at about 11 o'clock, A. He started immediately for Clarendon, a distance of sixteen miles. His horse was not a fleet one and he was three hours on a hot-making trip. When he reached town he was unable to get off his horse unaided. He placed himself under the care of Dr. Carhart, and at the present writing he is considered out of danger and is doing well and will return to camp in a day or two.

The case was a very severe one, owing to the length of time which elapsed before medical aid was obtained. Mr. Kilfoil exhibited great coolness of mind, and sundered wounds persisted for a long time.

But for this, he could not have been able to get to town.
