

TRUST FIGHTS UNION

STRUGGLE BETWEEN PUBLISHERS AND PRINTERS IN PITTSBURG.

Story of the Trouble From Its Inception—Injustice of Scale Greedy Employers Attempted to Enforce—Determined to Destroy the Union.

Special Correspondence. The contest between the Newspaper Publishers' association of Pittsburg and its locked out employees shows no signs as yet of coming to a speedy close.

The employers had unquestionably counted upon breaking the strike long before this, and every manner of inducement has been held out to the union men to desert their organization.

The causes which led to the present lockout lie deeper than the mere rejection of an alteration in the scale of wages.

The Publishers' association, especially one member of that body, desired to add to the already enormous profits accruing from the operation of its various plants.
