How to Mix Paint Colors
to Produce Desired Tint By mixing the primary colors
(red, yellow and blue) in various proportions, most colors can be ob-
tained. Mixing all three primary tained. Mixing all three primary
colors in equal parts gives a neutral color. By mixing any two of the three primary colors in proper proportion, the complementary or
secondary color results. For in. standary color results. For in-
stance, mixing blue and yellow will stance, mixing blue and yellow will
produce green, which is the complementary color to red. Yellow and
red produce orange, which is the red produce orange, which 1s the
complement of blue, while red and
blue produce vilelet, the compleblue produce violet, the comple-
ment of yellow. If the paint or enamel you have
purchased is not the exact tint or shade you wish, remember that you
can lighten any color by adding can llghten any color by adding
white or darken any shade by add-
ing blact Ing black. To lessen the brilliance
of a color, add its complement: blue to orange, green to red or yellow to violet.

sary to use a power sander, sinc sary to use a power sander, since
