This was chang- ed at the first session of the 79th Congress. The House in this Congress had 242 Democrats and 190 Republicans. On January 3, 1945 Rep. John E. Rankin, Democrat lution to give the Un-American Activities Committee the status of a regular standing House com- mittee. The vote on this resolution was 208 for and 186 against. Mr. Rankin is still in the foreMr. Rankin is still in the fore- front of the fight to expose the Reds. <br> The Dies Committee operated on a non-partisan basis and the sent Un-American Activities Committee until President Truman denounced the espionage inves tigations of this Committee as a "Red Herring" which automatically injected these investigations which have been made into the Presidential campaign. In making this denunciation, Mr. Truman lined up alongside Henry Wallace and his motely crew of commies and fellow travelers. <br> This Committee is trying to protect the American people by exposing and smashing a Russian spy ring and is therefore entitled to the wholehearted support of every true American, including the President and all his aides. <br> It is difficult for me and I imagine it is for a great many people, to understand why Mr. Truman refused to turn over to the Committee the employment records and the loyalty check reports of the present and former employees of the Government who have been named as of the Russian government, or fellow travelers, at the Committee hearings. The logical conclusion is that Mr. Truman is in fa- vor of the spy ring and wants vor of the spy ring and wants subversive persons on the payroll of the Government. But that definitely is not true, and since it isn't, the only other conclusion possible is that he is doing what he believes will help "him | REMEDY FOR THE <br> MEAT SITUATION <br> The meat situation has been the subject of more loose and uninformed talk than practical- ly anything else, ranging from unfounded charges that big profits are the cause of high prices, to political demands for a reimposition of price controls, which would discourage production and channel most of the available meat supply into black markets, In the light of that, a stateerican Meat Institute deserves wide reading. "The real remedy for the meat situation," it said, "is the production, as promptly will permit, of adequate numbers of meat animuls." It then went on to make a series of specific suggestions for achieving this goal. <br> First, farmers should be encouraged to breed sows for late fall and early winter farrowing. Second, producers should be urfeed spring pigs to reasonably heavy weights. Third, breeding herds should be rebuilt with younger stocks, and older, poorer producing cows should be marketed. Fourth, the slaughter of calves should be reduced. Fifth, producers must be assured of a for meat. Sixth, livestock conservation should be pushed. <br> This is a long range program, and it is based upon the sound principle that the country must have more meat - and that high meat prices are in large part the face of a limited supply. Rationing and other government controls, as any school child can understand, would not increase the supply of meat by a single pound.
