. Application forms must be completely filled out, signed, and dated.
2. Verification of income is required. Verification of residence, household composition, and resources is required, if questionable
3. Beginning September 1,2002 , the following Monthly Income Table shall be utilized in determining income standards. Maximum Countable income cannot exceed

4. Total countable resources and assets cannot exceed $\$ 2000$ or $\$ 3000$ if the household contains a relative who is aged or disabled. The value of a car greater than $\$ 4,650$ is counted against the $\$ 2000$ limit. Personal possessions and homestead are exempt assets
5. Eligible persons must be a resident of Hansford County.
6. Applicants must provide all information and documentation that is requested.
7. Applicants must apply for any other program for which they are potentially eligible. The county program is payer of last resort.
8. Applicants have the right to appeal denials
