## Property Tax Protest and <br> Appeal Procedures

After it decides your case, the ARB must send you a copy of its order by certified mail. If you're not satisfied with the decision, you have
the right to appeal to district court. If you choose to go to court, you by certified mail. If you re not satisfied with the decision, you have
the right to appeal to district court. If you choose to go to court, you
must start the process by filing a petition within 45 days of the date must start the process by filing a petition within 45 days of the date
you receive the ARB's order. If the appraisal district has appraised your property at $\$ 1,000,000$ or more, you must file a notice of appeal with the chief appraiser within 15 days of the date you receive the ARB's order.

You can get more information by contacting your appraisal district at 709 West 7 th Street, Spearman, Texas. You can also get a pamphlet describing how to prepare a protest from the appraisal district or from the State Comptroller's Property Tax Division at P.O. Box 13528 Austin, Texas $78711-3528$
The law gives property owners the right to protest actions concerning their property tax appraisals. You may follow these appeal proce dures if you have the value placed on your property any exemptions that may apply to you
the cancellation of an agricultural appraisal the taxable status of your property the local governments which should be taxing your property
any action taken by the appraisal district that adversely affected you.

Informal Review
The first option a taxpayer may use to protest a value is to visit with the chief appraiser or a staff member. Records on individual properiies are available for review by every taxpayer. This informal review is to the benefit of the taxpayer, as many protests are resolved at this level.

Review by the Appraisal Review Board
If you can't resolve your problem informally with the appraisal district staff, you may have your case heard by the appraisal review board (ARB).

The ARB is an independent board of citizens that reviews problems with appraisals or other concerns listed above. It has the power to order the appraisal district to make the necessary changes to solve notice of protest) before the deadline, the ARB will set your case for hearing You'll receive written notice of the time, date and place of the hearing. The hearing will be informal. You and the appraisal district representative will be asked to present eveidence about you district representative The ARB will make its decision based on the evidence pre

## Deadline for Filing Protests with the ARB ${ }^{*}$

## Usual Deadline

On or before May 31 (or 30 days after a notice of appraised value was mailed to you, whichever is later)

Late protests are allowed if you miss the usual deadline for good cause. Good cause is some reason beyond your control, like a medical emergency. The ARB decides whether you have a good cause.
Late protests are due the day before the appraisal review board approves records for the year. Contact your appraisal district for more information.

## Special Deadlines

For change of use (the appraisal district informed you that you are losing agricultural appraisal because you changed the use of your land), the deadline is before the 30th day after the notice of the determination was mailed to you.

For ARB changes (the ARB has informed you of a change that protest you filed), the deadline is before the 30th day after the notice of the determination was mailed to you

If you believe the appraisal district or ARB should have sent you a notice and did not, you may file a protest until the day before axes become delinquent (usually February 1). The ARB de cides whether it will hear your case based on evidence about whether a required notice was mailed to you.
