QUESTION: Some educators have said we should eliminate report cards and
marks. Do you think this is a good idea?
DR. DOBSON: No, academic marks are valuable for students in the third grade or higher. They serve as a form of
reinforcement-as a reward for the child who has achieved in school and as a nudge to the youngster who hasn't.
It is important, though, that marks be used properly; they have the power to create or to destroy motivation. Through the elementary years and in the required courses of high school, a
