## Rachelle Holt Rides To Nationals

State University barrel racer advance to the College National Finals Rodeo.
Rachelle Holt, 21 , is in Casper. Wyo this week (June 16-20) for CNFR. She finished the season third in the Central Plains region,
which includes schools in Oklahoma Texas and Kansas.
Holt, a senior, will compete in three long go Holt, a senior, will compete in three long go

The points did not come easy for Holt, formerly of Gruver, Texas, as she was only 70 points above the fourth place contestant.
"It was actually a dog fight until the odeo," she said. She jumped from fourth at the April 9-11 tional qualifying, third place position. She held third for the last two rodeos of the sea-
son. The final rodeo of the season was held April
an-25 in Miami. 23-25 in Miami. Holt said she almost lost the
third place position when her horse slipped and fell at that rodeo, but she held on to her position. "Odds say I shouldn't have made it back, but I guess I got lucky", Holt said.

contestants three in each contest, and Holt worked to achieve her goal. She was comper-
