


A friend of mine, Rodney Sumner, Spearman ISD Superintendent, Coaned me a video tape entitled "Molder of Dreams." It was about Guy Doud, the 1986 National Teacher of the Year, from Brainerd, Minnesota.
Mr. Doud is a very gifted speaker, who made some profound statements about school, teacfing, sports, and life in general.
I thought thiat I would share a few of these thoughts with you this week. These thoughts don't really tie in to each other, they are just a few things that really spoke to me in the video.
Mr. Doud spoke about popularity and fitting in, making the comment, "Why was it in 1st grade that I could afready tell you who the Homecoming king and queen would be?" As you can probably gather from the quote, fie was not one of the most popular kids in school. His popularity in school, fortunately, didn't Finder the impact thiat hie has made on thousards of students in Minnesota.
Another topic Mr. Doud talked about was sports. He talked about a student of his who was on the high school football team. He said the student told fim, "I can't believe that I am so bad that if they put me in the game that I would have blown the 20-point Cead." Mr. Doud commented that despite the fact that this player fiad been to every practice and been in the weight room the same as everyone else, somebody didn't trust his ability enough to put fim in the game.
Mr. Doud related the experience of being named 1986 National Teacher of the Year. Upon receiving this honor, he was invited to the White House to meet with President Ronald Reagan. He said that President Reagan read a poem to fiim entitled "Teachers." I would like to share that poem with you now.

## Teachers

You are the molders of dreams
The gods who build or crash their young beliefs of right and wrong
You are the spark that sets aflame the poets fiand Or fights the flame of some great singers song You are the god of the young, the very young You are the guardian of a million dreams Your every smile or frown can heal or pierce a heart You are a fiundred tives - a thousand lives
You are the pride of loving them and the sorrow, too Your patient work, your touch, make you the gods of hope
Who fill their souls and dreams to make those dreams come true

I would like to end this article with a quote and a scripture from Mr. Doud, "You love Jesus Christ only as much as the person you love the least."

- Y'ou are a letter from Christ, written by us. It is not a letter written with pen and ink, but by the Spirit of the living God; not one carved on stone, but in human hearts." 2 Corintfians, $3: 3$
I would also recommend that if you have the chance, watch the video.

May God bless and keep you; May He make his face to shiine upon you, and be gracious to you; May the Lord lift up his countenance upon you, and give you peace.
