 Is smokeless tobacco a safe alternative to cigarettes? The answer is "No", according to Sherri Scott, Tobacco Education Specialist of Public HealthRegion 1. Sherri spoke to junior Region 1. Sherri spoke to junior
high classes in Spearman and Gruver, and health classes in Gruver, High School on May 7 \& 8 . "It's simply untrue that snuff and chewing tobacco are somehow safe", according to Mrs. Scott. Smokeless tobacco can
ultimately lead to death, just ultimately lead to death, just
like cigarettes. There are four like cigarettes. There are four common myths about smokeless
tobacco.
Lie \#1: Chewing tobacco is Lie \#1: Chewing tobacco is
better for you because you don't inhale the smoke. True, there's no
smoke but there's still cancer to smoke but there's still cancer to
worry about. More than 87 percent worry about. More than 87 percent
of oral cancer cases are directly linked to smokeless tobacco and
cigarette use. Also, it only takes a cigarette use. Also, it only takes a
few months of regular use to few months of regular use to
develop mouth problems like leukoplakia, a disease that
results in ugly white patches or results in ugly white patches or
sores where tobacco touches the inside of your mouth. Over time, these areas can develop into oral
cancer. smokeless tobacco. Snuff and tobacco contain nicotine, a highly addictive poison that quickly enters the bloodstream via the
gums. An Iowa study of teenage gums. An Iowa study of teenage
boys, who mistakenly believed they could quit at anytime, showed that even when these boys developed suspicious lesions
in their mouths, a good percentage in their mouths, a good percentage habit.
Lie \#3: Athletes use it, so it must be safe. This, proves that
even star athletes can be deadly even star athletes can be deadly
wrong about health issues, wrong about health issues.
Athletes who care about their bodies know the truth: Using tobacco of any kind results in poor lung function, faster heart rate,
increased blood pressure and decreased athletic ability Lie \#4: I brush my teeth often, so
tobacco won't affect me tobacco won't affect me. Tobacco
starts damage as soon as it hits starts damage as soon as it hits
the mouth. It harms the fragile the mouth. It harms the fragile
lining of the mouth and throat. At the minimum, users get stained teeth, bad breath, mouth sores that are slow to heal, and a
lowered sense of taste and smell. Brushing and using mouthwash do Brushing and using mouthwash do
not eliminate the tobacco smell or
the damage.
