## Words from Faith $\mathcal{E}$ Grace

 by Cecil R. Biggers, Lutheran Lay MinisterOur faith is inclusive, not exclusive, "Let th Our faith is inclusive, not exclusive, "Lee the Nations be glad and sing
Cr joy". This week's lessons are Isaiah 56:1-8, Psalm 67, Romans 11:1 32, and Matthew 15:10-28. Isaiah proclaims that god-fearing foreigners will be welcomed by God
the Psalmist extols God that His way may be known on earth and His saving power be known among all nations.
Paul, still worrying about his people, declares that God has not reject Paul, stiil worrying abour his peopie, declares that God has nor reject
d the Jew, but has used their stumbling to bring His Word to the Gentiles, and Paul hopes that the Jews will become "jealous" for God and
even more of them be saved. Thus, the love of God is for all who hear His voice.
Jesus teaches his hearers that what defiles us before God is not what ve eat or drink, but that which we hold in our hearts. If we hold evi
ntentions such as murder, adultery, formication, theft, false witness, o slander, this is what separates us from the Love of God.
Jesus is then approached by a Canaanite woman, a person no reaso Jesus is then approached by a Canaanite woman, a person no reason-
able Rabbi would even talk to, a aperson who would be excluded by the Jewish community, and she begs Jesus to heal her daughter of demon
possession. Jesus twice turns her down by saying, "I was sent only to the possession. Jesus wice urns her sown the of the house of Irael" and again, "It is not fair to take the chilren's food and throw it to the dogs". She answered, "Yes, Lord, but eve
