## Murder Charges Filed in Shooting

Hansford County's first murder charge in 17 years was filed last week against Gabino Anquiano Gutierrez, 54, of Spearman.
Gutierrez is accused in the shooting death of Evelina Rojas Luna, 51 also of Spearman.
Sheriff R. L. McFarlin and officer Pete Ochoa were directed to house on Endicott Street at approximately 2 a.m. Wednesday, July 18 , after being informed of a shooting by a man walking into the sheriff' According to the informant, he had been asked by Gutierrez to report he shooting to authorities.
Upon arrival at the home, Sheriff McFarlin and Deputy Ochoa found
