## Stamps, like post office, change

| Staff Writer <br> For those who remember the penny postcard and a three-cent first class stamp, today's post office is not what it used to be. <br> All kinds of merchandise emanate from the post office and even the common postage stamp is not ordinary. <br> Charles Britten, the Hereford postmaster since May 1985, agrees that the postal service has looked for new ways to make expense and revenue balance. <br> Besides stamps, a variety of items depicting certain stamps can be bought in the post office -- from "Love" nightshirts to picture puzzles. Stamps, though, still are the biggest commodity on sale and each year several new designs are issued, often matching holidays. <br> This year's holiday stamps -- one design features Santa Claus and another is a Madonna and Child -- were printed before the postal service's governing board decided whether to raise the price of a single first class stamp. <br> "These stamps don't have a price on them," said Britten, "because they thought the price would go from 29 cents to 30 cents." <br> Fortunately, foresight left a price off the stamps because the proposed postage increase of one cent was not approved. <br> Britten said there also may be two more holiday designs issued before Christmas. <br> Stamp-buyers often select stamps to match the mailing, pointed out Britten. <br> For instance, a bride-t-be may request the "Love" stamp for her wedding invitations. The 29 -cent Love stamp is an interesting design of a globe in the shape of a heart. <br> Obviously, holiday greeting cards will have the special seasonal stamps affixed. <br> "Usually, men don't care much what the stamp looks like," said Briten, "but women may ask to see the stamps available. Sometimes, they buy some of se veral kinds. <br> Each year, the U.S. Postal Service offers sets of stamps for sale. For |  |

"Little girls in China no longer have their feet crushed by footbinding, and widows in India are no longer supposed to be roasted alive on the funeraly pyres of their husbands.
"But a stark statistic testifies to women's continuing unequal status: at least 60 million females in Asia are missing and feared dead, victims of nothing more than their sex
"Worldwide, research suggests the number of missing females may top $\mathbf{1 0 0}$ million
"If sex discrimination in the West means office harrassment or fewer good jobs for women, in the Third World it often means death. A tradiitonal preference for boys--in China, India and many other developing countries--translates quickly into neglect and death for girls.
"The tens of millions of missing include females of all ages who are aborted or killed at birth or who die because they are given less food than males. Or, because family members view a daughter with diarrhea as as nusiance but son with diarrhea as medical crisis requiring a doctor.
"If a boy gets sick, the parents may send him to the hospital at once," acknowledged Li Honggui, an official in China's State Family Planning Commission. "But if a girl gets sick, the parents may say to themselves, 'Well, we'll see how she is tomorrow.' We reprint this story not to suggest that women in America don't know how well off they are, but to point out that democratic societies may not be perfect, but they've made great strides and continue to move forward in the area of human rights. o0o

## Where is reform?

local school property taxes increase at three times the rate of infation in one year. If that rate of increase continues, the property owners of Texas will

First Impressions
The store grounds were beautifully landscaped and very clean. signs were colorful and the outside displays atractive. Even from the parking lot, this store looked more like a well kept theme park than a supermarket.

Inside, the store was clean, bright, colorful and busy. It was cowded, but no one semmed to mind.

There was animation everywhere. Just like Disneyland's "Counry Bear Jamboree," life-like animals were singing the praises of Stew Leonard's. The Singing hens told the story of farm fresh eggs. A milk carton band sang the virtues of the store's fresh, wholesome milk. Clover, he cow, blinked and mooed on comana.

The store is laid out like a maze. The traditional front-to-back aisles do not exist at Stew Leonard's. When you enter, a winding aisle guides you through the entire inventory.

All store employees are dressed in bright uniforms. Everywhere looked they were at work keeping the shelves arranged and making and atras a beautiful store inside and
out.
According to store manager Jim Mount, The Original Stew Leonard's opened in 1969. The store has expanded 27 times and now ncompasses 106,000 square feet. Initially, the store carried only seven about 700 different items and employs more than 700 .
Why People Shop There
As I walked through the original Leonard's Store, I asked about a
dozen shoppers why they shopped there. "Quality" was always the first
answer. They mentioned the quality of the meat, fresh produce and the high standards of excelience throughout the store.

One woman who had driven neariy 40 miles to shop at Leonard's was emphatic about the difference. "I drove by a dozen good else."

I found the customers' answers very interesting. This store has worid-wide reputation for customer service, but shoppers come because of the quality. As I pressed for other reasons, most admitted tha it was a fun place to shop. They like the treatment they receive from the In

In my opinion, there are five reasons for Leonard's success. First, Leonard's carries only top quality items. Second, they promote the friendly and courteous. Fourth the prices are come ene siafi is aiways rien Low prices wer Form, value. Low presirely forus customprs Employees talk what could be improved

Stew Leonard's stores are successful because they stay close to their customers. They provide the quality, value and service that everyone wants in a warm and friendly atmosphere. Unrtunately, they can't quite give the script the lift it needs when the dialogue falls flat, as it occasionally does.

Does Chance have a chance? The film faces stuff competition on the Monday-night lineup, including heavy-hitting Murphy Brown on CBS, and NFL Football on ABC. Time and ratings will tell.

## FAAMOLD FAARPE

'Tiny Toons' airs
script by teen trio

With what has to be the most dramatically conceived cartoon in history, Warner Bros. has managed to create a half-hour of publicity thinly disguised as a Tiny Toons episode. In "Buster and Babs Go Hawaiian," he pint-sized spinoffs of favorite Cooney Tunes characters follow a scenario penned by a trio of eighthraders from Waynesboro, Va. Advance publicity indicales the handwritten script "miraculously" made its way into the hands of Toons executive producer Steven Spielberg, who decided to buy it. While it must be mmensely pleasing to the girls from irginia, the fruil of their efforts lacks he luster that usually rubs off on Spielberg productions.
The girls and the famous producer appear as caricatures in the cartoon, and the banter they exchange with Buster and Babs Bunny is designed to let viewers in on the story behind the story. However, these scenes were written after the girls' visit with Spielberg, and the result is an in-joke with no punch line. It would be a stretch, at best, to expect someone watching the show without a press kit to grasp the only real story here: the incredible luck of three young girls.
As one might expect, the animation is terrific, but the story, while pretty good for three eighth-grade girls, says more for having faith in the postal service than it does for big-budget cartoons.

## George Carlin at 'Shining Time Station'

NEW YORK (AP) Actor-comedian George Carlin's latest role calls for him to be about 18 inches tall.
"You have to compromise along the way sometimes," saysCarlin, the new Mr. Conductor of "Shining Time Station," PBS' preschooler show "and height is one of the compromisI' $m$ willing to make.

Carlin has taken over from Ringo Starr as the show's wee interlocuto and narrator of the Thomas the Tank Engine stories.
It's a big change to work in children's television, given "the rather delicious irony that I'mknown for my frank language, my candor," said Carlin, creator of the classic bit, Seven Words You Can't Say on Television."
"That's really only one part of my comedy, and my comedy is only one

It isn't the first time Carlin has ried to make his mark as an actor.
In his first flush of success in the 60 s , the short-haired, mainstreamlooking Carlin acted in a Doris Day with Marlo Thomas, and auditioned for the Brio Thomas, and auditioned or the Broadway stage.
"I did all these things and I just was never comfortable with the acting. I couldn't do it right, I didn't feel good, I wasn't there," he said. "So I had to put that aside rather than either embarrass myself or starve." He let his hair and beard grow
concentrated on his comedy, and was phenomenally successful. By the time the bearded, long-haired Carlin starred in "Carwash" in the mid-'70s, "I'd been hopelessly typecast.

In the mid-'80s, he began to study acting and the film roles began coming, including "Outrageous Fortune," "Bill and Ted's Excellent Adventure," TV movies for Disney and Fox, and the Bill and Ted movie sequel.
