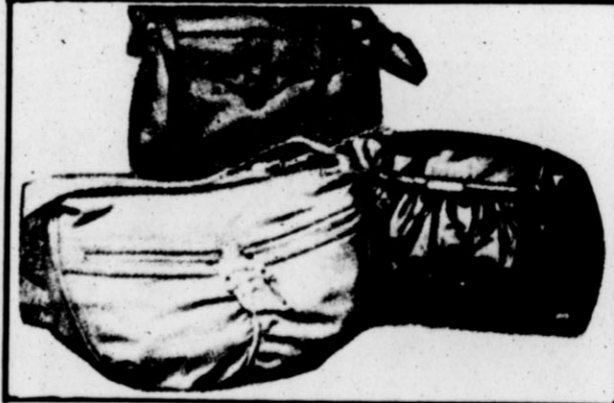

Coal-powered Tolk Station to have open house

Employees of Southwestern Public Service Company will show off their second coal-fired power plant, Tolk Station Unit No. 1, near Muleshoe Saturday and Sunday (Nov. 20 and 21), and everyone in the SPS service area is invited to the open house, said Troy Waddell, district manager in Hereford. The new coal-fired unit will be of significant help in Southwestern Public Service Company's effort to hold

down the rising costs for the fuels required to generate electricity, Waddell said. When it is generating at capacity, the 561,000-kilowatt Tolk Unit No. 1 — the largest unit ever built by SPS — will be able to supply the electricity needs of 225,000 people. Tours of the plant will begin at 10 a.m. and continue until 4 p.m. on Saturday. Tours will continue from 1 p.m. until 4 p.m. on Sunday, Waddell said. Casual dress is sug-

gested. Women should wear slacks and low heels. Tolk Station is located just south of U.S. Highway 60, about 10 miles east of Muleshoe (eight miles west of Earth.) The power plant is easy to find, Waddell said. The building which houses the boiler is 237 feet tall — about the height of a 20-story office building. The chimney stack, from which cleaned flue gases

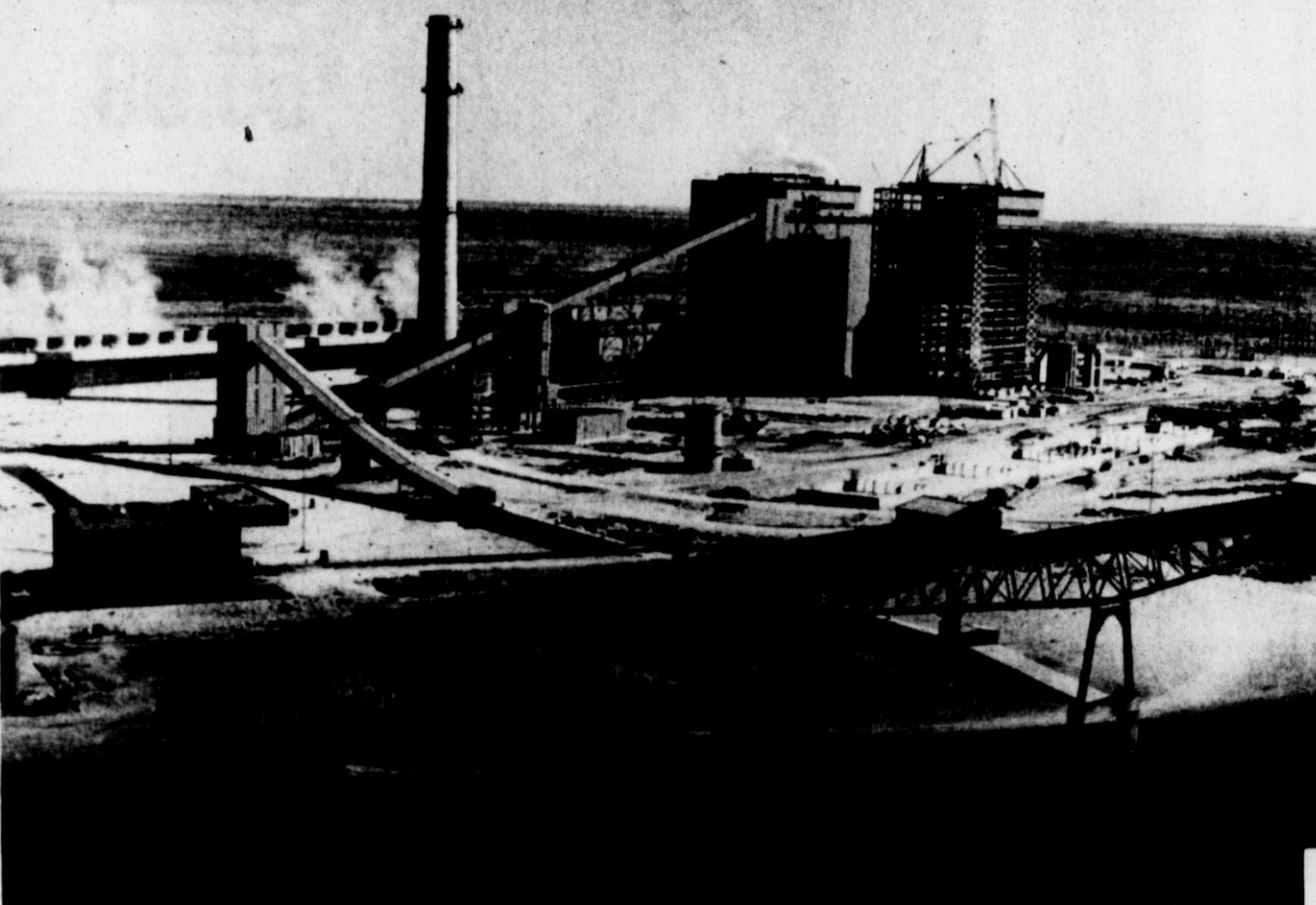
from the boiler exit, towers 400 feet above the sand hills which surround the power plant. The great size of the plant is required to house equipment large enough to supply the region's ever-growing demand for electricity, said Berl Springer, chairman of the board and chief executive officer of Southwestern Public Service. "We're immensely proud of Tolk Station, which was

designed by our own engineers," Springer said. "We know it will help us serve our customers in the Hereford area, and all our customers, more economically. And the availability of more 45,000-square-mile, four-state service area. SPS serves more than one million people in the south plains and Panhandle of Texas, eastern and southwestern New Mexico, the Oklahoma Panhandle, and southwestern Kansas. Springer said SPS is one of only four major electric utility companies in the United States that employs its own in-house plant design engineers. SPS engineers led by Bill Esler, vice president, engineering, and Jim Matthews, generation design and construction group manager, also oversee construction of the power plants they design, Springer said.

The turbine at maximum output produces about 728,000 horsepower. The main steam piping at the Unit contains high pressure steam with flow rates as high as 3,800,000 pounds of steam per hour. Bert Ballengee, president and chief operating officer of Southwestern Public Service, said detailed planning and design for Tolk Station, which is named after former SPS board chairman Roy Tolk, began in 1975. General construction contractor for the plant was Missouri Valley Inc., of Amarillo; the electrical contract work was done by Budwine Service Electric of Carlsbad, N.M. Other companies were contracted to build the evaporative cooling towers and the rail spur to the plant, and to do fencing, paving and insulation work. On-site construction of the plant involved hundreds of craftsmen and laborers over a period of more than four years. Sometimes, there were as many as 800 workers on site. Only 150 people are required to operate the Tolk

Unit 24 hours a day, Ballengee said. Cost of the Unit was \$228.2 million, excluding allowance for funds used during construction of \$48.3 million. Cost per installed kilowatt of capacity was \$489. "The unit came on-line on schedule and within budget," Ballengee said. "We at SPS are especially proud that Tolk, like our other coal-fired plant, Harrington Station near Amarillo, was completed less than one-half the national average cost for coal-fired plants. Obviously, when we can perform like that, we're saving our customers a lot of money." A second, identical unit at the Muleshoe site, Tolk Station Unit No. 2, is now under construction. It is scheduled to be in service in 1985. The second unit will share some of Unit No. 1's largest equipment, including the on-site coal-handling system, the water treatment facility, and the offices and control room. Economy is the major benefit Tolk Station will afford SPS customers Waddell said, explaining, "The more we can use coal to fuel our power plants, the more money we can save or customers."

SPS' average fuel cost in 1982 to make one kilowatt-hour of electricity generated by natural gas, Ballengee said, was 3.178 cents. The fuel cost of kilowatt-hour generated by coal, he said, "by contrast, was only 1.803 cents." "So, one of the main ways we're helping our customers — or, as we express it in our Company's theme, our partners — manage electricity," he concluded, "is by maximizing use of our coal-fired plants." The Company's theme is "You and SPS, partners managing electricity, make the difference." Tolk Unit No. 1 in 1983 will raise SPS' generation by coal to 53.6 percent, Ballengee said. The environmental control system at the Tolk Unit No. 1 is another money saver, he said. The fabric filter system, called a baghouse, sifts "fly ash" from the boiler flue gases on their way to the 400-foot-high stack. SPS sells the captured fly ash for use in oil well mud, concrete, road and parking lot fill, and as a soil conditioner. The money made from the sale of the fly ash by-product is charged against the price SPS pays for coal. "That brings down the cost our customers pay for the fuel," Ballengee said. The coal-unloading system SPS uses at Tolk also saves customers' money, he said. Instead of bringing coal from Wyoming in heavy bottom-dump railroad cars, and emptying the coal from trestles into a stockpile, SPS has its Tolk coal shipped in lighter-weight "rotary dump" cars. The lighter-weight cars are rolled over on their sides in a "rotary dump house" at Tolk, and the fuel costs, Ballengee said, "because use of the lighter-weight cars means SPS is hauling in more coal per freight dollar."

TFU leaders work on policy

WACO — Joe Morris of Gruver and Steve Cleavinger of Dalhart representing District 1 of the Texas Farmers Union were in Waco this week for the first of two sessions of the Texas Farmers Union Policy Drafting Committee. Morris and Cleavinger have been officially appointed as two of 14 farmers from across the state to serve on this special panel. The committee is responsible for preparing policy statements of the general farm organization for debate and adoption during the Texas Farmers Union state convention which takes place January 20-22 in Austin.

Representatives are appointed annually to this committee in order to take policy resolutions submitted by county organizations along with amendments and updates and incorporate them into appropriate sections of TFU's existing policy. The policy addresses each commodity as well as many other concerns of family farmers ranging from state and local issues to national and international matters. Among some of the more significant policies which were adopted by the committee include: A recommendation that the price of cotton be established on grade and staple only, eliminating the micronaire base. Enaction of legislation that would provide improved protection and the sanctity of ownership of producer-owned commodities stored in warehouses. Opposition to the 50 cents milk tax. Opposition to any actions that would weaken the Farm Credit System.

COLLEGE STATION — Farm-City Week, Nov. 19-25, focuses on the involvement of farm and city people as partners in growing, processing, marketing and consuming food and fiber. "In Texas, movement of food and fiber from field to factory to the family table provides jobs and income for about a fourth of the working force," points out Dr. Carl Anderson, marketing economist with the Texas Agricultural Extension Service. "One out of every 30 Texans is a farmer or rancher, and 30 percent of the state's retail trade business is direct-

ly associated with agricultural production and selling of food and fiber products," says Anderson. Many businesses, financial institutions and individuals are involved in providing supplies, credit and services to farmers and ranchers and in

FmHA loans

The Farmers Home Administration (FmHA) provided loans to 7672 Texas farmers in Fiscal Year 1982 which ended on Sept. 30, FmHA State Director, J. Lynn Futch, announced today. Preliminary figures show that nationally the agency provided about 100,000 loans to farmers across the country. The total amount loaned through FmHA Farmer Programs was approximately \$4.1 Billion.

The breakdown of Farmer Program preliminary totals show that Texas FmHA provided 3001 farm operating loans for \$106,170,070; 205 farm ownership loans for \$16,307,270; 4401 natural disaster emergency loans for \$17,136,730; and 36 soil and water loans for \$805,700. Some farmers received more than one type of loan, Mr. Futch said.

processing and marketing agricultural commodities. Texas ranks in third place in total cash receipts among the leading agricultural states, behind California and Iowa. Texas, however, is number one in the sales of cattle and calves, cotton, grain sorghum, sheep and wool, goats and mohair, cabbage and spinach. Total farm assets in Texas are estimated at \$80 billion. With 186,000 farms in Texas, assets average \$430,000 per farm. Many commercial size, full-time operators, have in excess of a million dollars investing in their farm or ranch businesses.

"Producing an abundance of high quality food and fiber is inherent to American agriculture. Americans spend far less of their take-home pay on food than people in other countries of the world," Anderson points out. "Today that amounts to about 17 cents of every dollar of disposable income. Thoughts on prostate surgery

DEAR DR. LAMB - I am 52 years old and have some difficulties in urinating. My doctor told me that I have a small benign prostatic enlargement and that it requires an operation.

What kind of side effects can appear after such an operation? Is a male unable to perform sexually after a prostate operation? Is it true that a penile implant is necessary after a transurethral resection? What is a penile implant?

In my native country my doctor prescribed testosterone. My doctor here considers that testosterone is bad and should not be used in prostatic enlargement.

Considering the prostate enlargement is not very big, can you advise some medicine that can postpone the operation?

DEAR READER - A decision on whether prostate surgery is required really depends upon how much obstruction of the bladder it is causing. The prostate gland encircles the urethral tube that drains the bladder.

The prostate need not be greatly enlarged to cause severe obstruction. Think of the prostate gland as a doughnut and the urethral tube to drain the bladder passes through the hole in the doughnut. If the hole becomes smaller and smaller it can cause a lot of obstruction regardless of the overall size.

Obviously the more obstruction you have, the more difficulties you have with urination. The transurethral resection simply inserts an instrument through the urethral tube and electrically cuts out the center of the prostate, making the hole big enough for normal drainage. In most cases the surgery will not prevent normal sexual performance later. It will affect the valves that close off the bladder from the prostate and this causes the orgasm to pass backward into the

bladder rather than forward in the normal manner.

No, you will not need a penile implant if you return to normal sexual functions, which you should be able to do. Implants are for men who cannot obtain or sustain an erection.

British nuke war film very 'explicit'

NEW YORK (AP) - A pumpkin, standing in for a human head, is shredded by exploding glass. A leg of lamb is burnt to a crisp. Faces are charred beyond recognition.

There's nothing namby-pamby about the way British television portrays the effects of nuclear war in "Nuclear War: A Guide to Armageddon," a BBC import on public television tonight.

The disclaimer at the beginning of the broadcast - "Decide now who should or shouldn't watch" - should not be regarded in the same way American television warns about movies for mature audiences. It is not an idle advisory.

American audiences have come to expect sober, even-handed documentaries about nuclear war. Earlier this year, NBC talked about the effects of a nuclear explosion over Chicago. The BBC shows it. In detail.

"This is a film about facts which make no political point," says narrator Ludovic Kennedy, but don't believe it. Although politicians aren't on the program, an anti-nuclear point of view is clear.

"A Guide to Armageddon" is a powerful and jarring portrait, designed to agitate viewers. Some, however, will say it crosses the borders of good taste.

The segments on how people should try to prepare for a nuclear attack take on the absurd air of a Monty Python skit. For example, residents within a certain range of the blast who follow the instructions of the British government could survive "for 17 seconds," the broadcast says.

Those who build one sort of suggested shelter "might not only be roasted, but suffocated" as well. The program suggests additional problems, such as getting in to the shelter in time and keeping out the neighbors.

Officials say they're puzzled

TEXAS CITY, Texas (AP) - Officials at an Amoco Oil Co. refinery are puzzled by the demands made in a letter threatening the company's facilities if terminated workers are not rehired, the Houston Chronicle reported today.

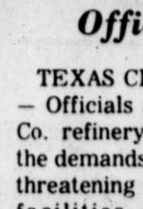
"The request for reinstatement is very broad," R.M. Bishop, employee relations manager for the refinery, told the paper.

"We do not know if it includes people who may have been let go from temporary jobs," he said. "We do not know if it includes people who were terminated during their probationary period. We do not know if it applies only to permanent employees."

There are vehicles for resolving disputes over the equity and justice of disciplinary discharges," he said. "These have always worked in the past. As employee relations manager, I have always been open to appeals for review of these questions. That avenue is open now either directly or through an intermediary."

The statement came after Amoco officials received the second threatening letter from a group calling itself "The People's Worker Revolutionary (sic) Committee for Worker Justice."

Amoco facilities have been checked for explosives, but none have been found, Huerta said.

English measures deciphered

DEAR POLLY - I have a number of old cookbooks that were published in England (they belonged to my British mother) and I'd love to prepare some of the recipes from them. However, I know that the measurements are not quite the same as American measurements - for example their tablespoon is not the same as our tablespoon. I've been unable to find a comparison chart. Do you have any information on this? - CINDY

DEAR CINDY - Here are the basic units and how they "measure" up. Dry ingredients: two American (or level) tablespoons equals British (or heaping) tablespoon. Liquid ingredients: two American pints equals one and three-fourths Imperial (British) pint; one and one-fourth American pints equals one Imperial pint. This should get you through most recipes successfully. Obviously measurements in pounds and ounces, which are used consistently in British recipes (as opposed to our "cups"), are the same here as there and can be weighed out on any good household and kitchen scale. - POLLY

DEAR POLLY - To keep preschoolers busy for a while, sit them in a large empty open box or laundry basket with an old magazine and a pair of safe blunt-end scissors. They can while away the time cutting out pictures to make collages and the mess of paper scraps stays in the box.
