## Open records

Athough the Open Records Act has been in effect in Texas for quite
meme time, there are still public officials who believe that they can hide ertain records safe from prying eyes.
The Open Records Act became law in 1973 as part of the reaction to he Sharpstown scandal where the Texas Speaker of the House became involved in real estate deals which were illegal.
This law requires that all information collected, assembled or maintaine by or for government bodies in Texas is "public
to the public with only certain exceptions.
This means that material put on file by any government body is available oinspection by the public. The law provides that a charge may be made or providing copies of this material but all of it is available.
This also means that any citizen can go to a county clerk's office or and filed for public record.
Those whose names appear in these public records may not especiall want other people to inspect various documents, but the law is clear, public
$\qquad$ The purpose of the law is to make available to people full and complete Iformation about the affairs of their government. It is true that ver few private citizens make the effort to dig into these public records. They ieaver that u.

## Flutist James Galway: a puckish Pan



 conductor Gerrard Schwarz. in tite nowest Live from Lincoin Conter, alining Wedneedioy on Pess. my hobby," says Irish-born flutist James Galway in a musical brogue. His "hobby" involves a performance schedule that sweeps him across continents and time zones at the dizzying pace of 100 concerts a year from Italy to Japan.
Indeed, Galway does his work with an enviable relish, performing classical and popular music by composers from Johann Bach to John Denver. When he is not in concert or in the recording studio, he teaches master classes, works on books about flute-playing or relaxes with one or another of his disciples. (They get together for the weekend and - what else? - play the lute.) He says no piece of music ever gets stale to him, betraying his secret in the very words he uses to describe his gif: "I can make a piece fresh every time I play with it. I always enjoy the turn of phrase, or the moment of sadness, or the moment of great elation.
As the world's pre-eminent flutist, Galway can perform anywhere he likes, but he chooses his concert schedule carefully. "Mostly I play in places I like. If you do a hundred concerts a year, like I do, and you considered it like a hundred dinners, and you thought, 'T'm only going to get a hundred,' you'd go to the best restaurants. And people will tell you, 'There's a good Italian restaurant here,' but you know darn well that the best talian restaurants are in Italy." The comparison is no accident; Galway seems to enjoy playing his flute with the same gusto as his more tactule pleasures - eating. drinking or smoking a pipe or cigar. This summer, as usual, Galway's itinerary includes a stop at Lincoln Center's Mostly Mozart Festival, where he made his New York debut
some 13 years ago. "It's always pleasure," he says, "to go back to New York and play for these people who were the first to promote me in America. And then, of course, the New York audience is wild, rllt tell you. You really have to know your onions when you sit down to play for them."

The Festival's silver-anniversary season inaugural airs Wednesday, July 10, over most Public Broadcasting affiliates. Appearing with Galway and the Mostly Mozart Orchestra, led by conductor Gerard Schwarz, is pianist Andre Watts, who will play Mozart's Piano Concerto No. 9.
Galway has chosen Mozart's Flute Concerto in $\mathbf{G}$ for the occasion. "It's he first one (of two) that Mozart wrote, and it really is a flute concerto beyond any shadow of a doubt. I think Mozart was more thoughtful about it and he spent a lot of time - like 10 minutes $\rightarrow$ writing it," he concludes, with a giggle.

II commissioned a flute concerto from a young British composer, David Heath. He writes a lot of jazzy things, and he opened up the concerto with his alto flute motif.
"And that's an interesting thing," Galway adds, "because I don't have a gold alto flute, so I just ordered one, gold keys and all.
"(The debut of the Heath concerto) is coming up in about 18 months. I'm waiting for the flute to get made. Actually, I'm waiting for the flutemaker to pick himself up off the floor. Nobody ever ordered a flute like this before."
And, it can be said, nobody ever played a flute like this before, either

## HBO looks at baseball＇s Golden Age <br> is featured <br> Series，played within the ivy－covered <br> cootage of the old Negro Leagues and

Before the days of multimillion－ dollar player contracts，before the emergence of television and mass exposure，baseball and those who played it captured the American imagination．Through the Depression and World War II，players like Dizzy kept spirits alive simply by chasing a ball between two chalk lines．
Thanks to the discovery of more than 40 hours of film（much it found in attics，trunks，etc．），including color footage of Babe Ruth and Jackie Robinson，HBO and Black Canyon Productions have recaptured that time in When It Was a Game，debuting Monday，July 8，on HBO．
The documentary takes fans back to the days of grass fields，when the Braves were in Boston and the A＇s in Philadelphia．It visits ballparks like Ebbets Field and Comiskey Park and offers highlights of the 1938 World

Hall of Famers are represented in this look at the national pastime（roughly， from the 1930s to the＇50s），and actors James Earl Jones，Jason Robards and Roy Scheider contribute readings from historic baseball lore．
The show offers historical perspec tive on the game，beginning with the hard－nosed，Depression－era play of the St．Louis Cardinals＇famed Gas House Gang，and recalls President Roo sevelt＇s assessment that＂They shouldn＇t quit playing just because there＇s a war going on．＂It also recounts the post－War boom and now－classic battles between the New York Yankees and Boston Red Sox teams of the late 1940s．
However，the documentary spends little time chronicling the most impor tant event in the history of American sports：integration．Players like Robin son，Roy Campanella，Willie Mays and Satchel Paige are seen，but there is no

After the war he drifted to Hollywood, picking up odd jobs and bit parts in films. His friend and mentor, John Wayne, recommended him for the role of Matt Dillon. Baseball feud takes All-Star break By Steve Paschal Like a dysfunctional family at Christmas, the American and National Leagues will try to put aside their differences Tuesday night, July 9, when they meet on CBS in the 62nd Major League Baseball All-Star Game.
Team owners in the two leagues have barely been on speaking terms since last month, when baseball commissioner Fay Vincent showed clear bias toward the National League by ruling that the American League must provide $\mathbf{5 0}$ percent of the players for new franchises in Miami and Denver while getting only 25 percent of the $\$ 95$ million expected to be paid by each of the expansion cities.
There hasn't been any love lost between the two leagues since the Boston Red Sox of the upstart American League stunned the Pittsburgh Pirates of the firmly-established National League in the first World Series back in 1904. The next year John T. Brush, owner of the NL champion Giants, refused to play the AL Champion Red Sox, calling the junior circuit a "bunch of minor leaguers," and the bad blood began to flow. It wasn't until almost 30 years later that a Chicago newspaper devised the All-Star Game as a way of determining which league had better overall talent.
The American League won that first meeting, but the National League holds a commanding 37-23-1 lead in the series.
