GONN. West Germany (AP) - A West German commando force was flying
home in triumph from East Africa today affer a blitz raid on a hi-jacted Lufthansa

surviving hostages and killed three of the surviving hostag

Later in the night after the failure of the hijacking was announced, three of the whose freedom the hijackers demanded

critical condition. The Entebbe-style rescue operation carly today at Mogadishu, the capital of
